AZ H 2635 Fleming (D)
Title: Procurement Services
Introduced: 02/01/2010
Status: Failed - Adjourned
Summary: Relates to procurement services; relates to outsourcing prohibited.

AZ H 2636 Fleming (D)
Title: Outsourcing
Introduced: 02/01/2010
Status: Failed - Adjourned
Summary: Relates to outsourcing; relates to state service positions; relates to prohibition.

AZ S 1429 Hale (D)
Title: Outsourcing and State Service Positions
Introduced: 02/01/2010
Status: Failed - Adjourned
Summary: Relates to outsourcing; relates to state service positions; relates to prohibition.

CONNECTICUT

CT S 79 McKinney (R)
Title: Agency Consolidation
Introduced: 02/08/2010
Status: Failed
Summary: Concerns agency consolidation and the outsourcing of government services; reduces the state deficit by consolidating agencies and outsourcing government services.

CT S 242 Joint Committee on Labor and Public Employees
Title: Retention of Jobs in Connecticut
Introduced: 02/19/2010
Status: Failed - Adjourned
Summary: Concerns the retention of jobs in Connecticut; helps keep jobs in Connecticut and stem the economic damage caused by outsourcing.

FLORIDA

FL H 717 Zapata (R)
Title: Procurement of Contractual Services and State Agency
Introduced: 03/02/2010
Status: Failed
Summary: Relates to procurement of contractual services and a state agency; provides with respect to requirements relating to provision of outsourced human services related to mental health, substance abuse, child welfare, or juvenile justice; requires acceptance by state agencies of national accreditation of providers of such human services in lieu of, and as substitute for, specified

FL S 1584 Smith (D)
Title: Procurement of Contractual Services and State Agency

Introduced: 03/02/2010
Status: Failed
Summary: Relates to procurement of contractual services and state agency; provides requirements with respect to the provision of outsourced human services related to mental health, substance abuse, child welfare, or juvenile justice. Requires the Social Services Estimating Conference to convene quarterly for the purpose of developing information related to mental health, substance

FL S 2386 Alexander (R)
Title: State Financial Matters
Introduced: 03/11/2010
Status: Enacted. 05/28/2010. Signed by Governor. Filed as Chapter No. 151
Summary: Regards payment by electronic funds transfer and cardholder data security, state purchasing categories thresholds, the procurement of products with recycled content, competitive solicitation, agency contract conflicts-of-interest, unfair vendor competition, outsourcing of projects, contracts for health and human services, and contracting with in-state companies.

FL S 2716 Aronberg (D)
Title: Outsourcing of Services and Activities By the State
Introduced: 03/11/2010
Status: Failed
Summary: Relates to outsourcing of services and activities by the state; requires a contract for a proposed outsourcing by the state to prohibit a contractor from authorizing an automatic increase in the salaries or benefits of its employees; requires a contract for a proposed outsourcing by the state to require the contractor to submit a written request to an agency for an increase in certain employee's salaries or benefits.

GEORGIA

GA H 1194 Rogers Ca (R)
Title: County and District Departments
Introduced: 02/16/2010
Status: Failed - Adjourned
Summary: Relates to county and district departments, boards, and directors of family and children services; provides for the outsourcing of certain duties; provides for related matters; repeals conflicting laws.

GA SR 859 Hill Ju (R)
Title: Minerals Management Service
Introduced: 01/26/2010
Status: Adopted 04/27/2010
Summary: (Resolution) Urges the Minerals Management Service of the United States Department of the Interior to include all outer continental shelf planning areas in its proposed five-year plan for 2010 through 2015 and to approve the broadest possible five-year plan for offshore development.

HAWAII

HI S 1136 Hanabusa (D)
Title: Hawaii Health Systems Corporation Outsourcing
Introduced: 01/27/2009
Status: Failed - Adjourned
Summary: Authorizes Hawaii Health Systems Corporation to outsource for services.

ILLINOIS

IL H 3761 Walker (D)
Title: Job Preservation Act
Introduced: 02/25/2009
Status: Adjourned

Summary: Creates the Job Preservation Act of 2009. Provides that companies that lose 100 or more employees due to outsourcing of jobs are ineligible to receive procurement contracts with the State, units of local government, or school districts and to receive government grants, loans, tax incentives, or other economic incentives. Requires certain companies that lose 100 or more

IL H 4161 Connelly (R)
Title: Creates the Council on Efficient Government Act
Introduced: 02/27/2009
Status: Adjourned
Summary: Creates the Council on Efficient Government Act. Creates the council and sets forth its duties, including review of whether goods and services provided by State agencies should be privatized or outsourced to obtain cost savings or best value. Requires reports. Requires business case analyses. Sets forth outsourcing contract requirements. Requires the council to establish an accounting method. Exempts transportation construction.

IL H 5470 Farnham (D)
Title: Growing Economy Tax Credit Act
Introduced: 02/04/2010
Status: Adjourned
Summary: Maintains, beyond the period during which it receives the tax credit, employment payrolls at an agreed upon level; provides an administrative penalty if the taxpayer fails to maintain employment payrolls due to labor outsourcing to other states or countries.

IL S 257 Noland (D)
Title: Job Preservation Act of 2009
Introduced: 02/04/2009
Status: Adjourned
Summary: Creates the Job Preservation Act of 2009. Provides that companies that lose 100 or more employees due to outsourcing of jobs are ineligible to receive procurement contracts with the State, units of local government, or school districts and to receive government grants, loans, tax incentives, or other economic incentives. Requires certain companies that lose 100 or more

LOUISIANA

LA SCR 33 Peterson (D)
Title: Administration Division
Introduced: 04/07/2010
Status: Failed - Adjourned
Summary: Directs the division of administration to publicly disclose the savings to be achieved by outsourcing services currently performed by state employees and the benefits that the contractor will be providing its employees prior to entering any contract outsourcing such services.

MICHIGAN

MI H 4816 Walsh (R)
Title: State Payroll Outsourcing
Introduced: 04/21/2009
Status: Adjourned
Summary: Provides for true determination of cost of providing payroll services in state government and to bid the function to private vendors.

MINNESOTA

MN H 1530 Hornstein (DFL)
Title: Metropolitan Airports Commission
Introduced: 03/09/2009
Status: Failed - Adjourned

Summary: Relates to the Metropolitan Airports Commission; requires the commission to prohibit outsourcing of certain jobs.

MN S 1366 Dibble (DFL)
Title: Metropolitan Airports Commission
Introduced: 03/12/2009
Status: Failed - Adjourned
Summary: Relates to the Metropolitan Airports Commission; requires the commission to prohibit outsourcing of certain jobs.

MONTANA

(2011) MT D 14 Brueggeman
Title: Outsourcing
Prefiled: 08/24/2009
Status: Pending - Draft in legal review Nov. 2010.
Summary: Revises state procurement laws to identify outsourcing.

NEW HAMPSHIRE

NH H 133 Weed (D)
Title: Department of Labor
Introduced: 01/07/2009
Status: Adjourned
Summary: Requires companies that have reduced their employment in New Hampshire by 50 or more employees to supply certain information to the department of labor including the number of jobs that were lost to outsourcing to foreign countries.

NH LSR 410 Weed (D)
Title: Department of Labor
Prefiled: 11/25/2008
Status: Adjourned
Summary: Requires employers to report certain information regarding outsourcing to the department of labor.

NEW JERSEY

NJ A 998 Ramos (D)
Title: Outsource Jobs Overseas-concerns
Introduced: 01/12/2010
Status: Adjourned
Summary: Prohibits businesses that outsource jobs overseas from receiving State contracts or grants; prohibits investment of State funds in such businesses.

NJ SR 22 Gill (D)
Title: Air Force Contracts
Introduced: 02/01/2010
Status: Adjourned
Summary: Opposes outsourcing of United States military manufacturing and respectfully urges Congress to investigate Air Force tanker contract award.

NEW YORK

NY A 1480 Wright (D)
Title: New York Consumer and Worker Protection Act
Introduced: 01/07/2009
Status: Adjourned

Summary: Enacts the New York consumer and worker protection act; requires employers to provide notice of the outsourcing of jobs prior to such outsourcing; prohibits any governmental agency from engaging in the practice of outsourcing jobs; requires consumers be made aware and provide consent if such consumers nonpublic personal information is disclosed to nonaffiliated third parties by any corporation or other business entity.

NY A 4250 Brodsky (D)
Title: Outsourcing of Jobs Regulations
Introduced: 02/02/2009
Status: Adjourned
Summary: Prohibits the outsourcing of jobs by business entities receiving state financial incentives; provides for repayment thereof and a five-year ban on assistance for violations; provides for enforcement by the Attorney General; requires state entities providing financial incentives to business entities

NY A 5677 Ball (R)
Title: Denies Tax Benefits for Outsourcing to a Foreign entity
Introduced: 02/17/2009
Status: Adjourned
Summary: Denies tax benefits to any corporation that outsources any of its business to a foreign entity or country.

NY A 11299 Titus (D)
Title: State Funding Restrictions
Introduced: 05/25/2010
Status: Adjourned
Summary: Prohibits state funding to business entities that outsource jobs.

NY S 3814 Adams (D)
Title: York Consumer and Worker Protection Act
Introduced: 04/01/2009
Status: Adjourned
Summary: Enacts the New York Consumer and Worker Protection Act; requires employers to provide notice of the outsourcing of jobs prior to such outsourcing; prohibits any governmental agency from engaging in the practice of outsourcing jobs; requires consumers be made aware and provide consent if such consumers nonpublic personal information is disclosed to nonaffiliated third parties by any corporation or other business entity.

NY S 7594 Addabbo (D)
Title: State Funding to Business Entities
Introduced: 04/23/2010
Status: Adjourned
Summary: Prohibits state funding to business entities that outsource jobs.

OKLAHOMA

OK H 3258 Blackwell (R)
Title: Children
Introduced: 02/01/2010
Status: Failed - Adjourned
Summary: Relates to children; requires the Department of Human Services to develop plan to outsource foster care services; defines term; specifies that a nonprofit agency shall serve as the lead agency in implementing plan; provides deadline for submission of plan; provides deadline for implementation of plan; provides for collaboration in the development of plan; specifies methodology.

PENNSYLVANIA

PA H 439 Petri (R)
Title: Agency Contract Prohibition

Introduced: 02/13/2009
Status: Adjourned
Summary: Amends the Procurement Code. Prohibits Commonwealth agencies from awarding contracts to bidders engaged in outsourcing of jobs or functions.

PA H 440 Petri (R)
Title: Agency Contract Prohibition
Introduced: 02/13/2009
Status: Adjourned
Summary: Amends the Procurement Code. Prohibits Commonwealth agencies from awarding contracts to bidders engaged in outsourcing of jobs or functions.

PA H 441 Petri (R)
Title: Agency Contract Prohibition
Introduced: 02/13/2009
Status: Adjourned
Summary: Amends the Procurement Code. Prohibits Commonwealth agencies from awarding contracts to bidders engaged in outsourcing of jobs or functions.

PA H 687 Dermody (D)
Title: Energy Savings Contracts
Introduced: 03/03/2009
Status: Enacted. 07/02/2010 Signed by Governor. Act No. 39
Summary: Amends the Procurement Code. Relates to a technology upgrade to reduce water or wastewater consumption or operating costs. Provides for notice of award. Includes plumbing fixtures, billing equipment upgrades and electronic systems. Excludes savings from outsourcing or using contract workers to perform tasks previously performed by government employees. Provides that a guaranteed energy savings contract may provide for payment over time and for an installment payment or lease purchase plan.

PA H 1364 Goodman (D)
Title: Administrative Code of 1929
Introduced: 04/27/2009
Status: Adjourned
Summary: Amends The Administrative Code of 1929. Provides for private operation funds. Provides that no Commonwealth funds appropriated to the Department of Corrections may be used to privatize or outsource commissary services of State correctional institutions.

PUERTO RICO

PR H 1428 Cruz Soto (PPD)
Title: Government Contractor Service Billing
Introduced: 04/13/2009
Status: Pending – Active Carryover
Summary: Amends existing law to establish that any contractor of any agency, instrumentality or agency of the Government of Puerto Rico must file a monthly bill for services rendered through government bills including those relative to outsourcing and subcontracting.

PR S 207 Muniz Cortes (PNP)
Title: Education Department Printing Services
Introduced: 01/13/2009
Status: Pending – Active Carryover
Summary: Orders the Department of Education to use the program for production and dissemination of educational materials, commonly known as printing services; authorizes the outsourcing of editorial projects in the private sector only when the number of jobs exceeds the capacity of the printing press.

SOUTH CAROLINA

SC S 984 Rose (R)
Title: Council on Efficient Government
Introduced: 01/12/2010
Status: Failed - Adjourned
Summary: Creates the council on efficient government; provides the powers and duties of the council; provides the requirements of a state agency proposal to outsource goods or services; provides for an accounting method to be used by the council.

TENNESSEE

TN H 2822 Cobb T (D)
Title: Public Contracts
Introduced: 01/22/2010
Status: Enacted. 06/23/2010 Signed by Governor. 06/25/2010 Public Chaptered. Chapter No. 1091
Summary: Prohibits the state or any of its departments, agencies, or political subdivisions from entering into a contract for services performed by or at call centers, with a vendor, wherever located, who uses, or plans to outsource such services to be provided by, in or by any person residing in a foreign country.

TN H 2998 DeBerry J (D)
Title: Taxes
Introduced: 01/26/2010
Status: Failed - Adjourned
Summary: Relates to ad valorem taxes; allows a municipality to contract with another collecting official to outsource processing of property tax relief applications; permits waiver of the deadline of an application for good and reasonable cause.

TN S 2839 Stewart E (D)
Title: Public Contracts
Introduced: 01/26/2010
Status: Failed - Adjourned
Summary: Relates to public contracts; prohibits the state or any of its departments, agencies, or political subdivisions from entering into a contract for services performed by or at call centers, with a vendor, wherever located, who uses, or plans to outsource such services to be provided by, in or by any person residing in a foreign country.

TN S 3361 Kyle (D)
Title: Taxes Ad Valorem
Introduced: 01/28/2010
Status: Enacted. 05/26/2010 Signed by Governor. 05/28/2010 Public Chaptered. Chapter No. 932
Summary: Allows a municipality to contract with another collecting official to outsource processing of property tax relief applications; permits waiver of the deadline of an application for good and reasonable cause.
