ALABAMA

AL S 454 Smitherman (D)
Title: Athletic Trainers Licensure Act
Status: Failed - Adjourned
Summary: Relates to the Alabama Athletic Trainers Licensure Act; deletes the title apprentice athletic trainer and replaces it with athletic training student; expands further certain definitions; deletes obsolete dates.

ARIZONA

AZ H 2089 SeeI (R)
Title: Apprentice Embalmers
Status: Failed - Adjourned
Summary: Relates to technical correction; relates to apprentice embalmers.

AZ S 1225 Burton-Cahill (D)
Title: Apprentice State Construction Projects
Status: Failed - Adjourned
Summary: Relates to apprentices; relates to state construction projects.

CALIFORNIA

CA A 165 Carter (D)
Title: Microenterprises: Economic Development
Status: Failed
Summary: Revises the definition of microenterprise. Expresses Legislative findings regarding the self-employment workforce and the importance of access to training for entrepreneurial and self-employment provided under the federal Workforce Investment Act. Requires the Workforce Investment Board to develop guidelines for high-wage industry sectors, make recommendations on how to target resources to those sectors, and recommend policy and provide technical assistance on entrepreneurial training opportunities.

CA A 395 Fuentes (D)
Title: Employment: Apprenticeship Programs
Status: Enacted: 10/11/2009
Summary: Relates to existing law exempting certain public works projects from the prevailing wage requirements if the awarding body contracting for public work initiates a labor compliance program and ensures compliance with prevailing rate wage laws. Provides that an awarding body that implements a labor compliance program may assist in the enforcement prevailing rate wage laws. Allows a contractor to appeal the result of a labor compliance program enforcement action. Deposits any penalties in the General Fund.

CA A 1226 Huber (D)
Title: Workplace Learning
Status: Failed
Summary: Allows a school district to report for state apportionments average daily attendance in classes that are not open to the general public if the classes are held in the workplace, are intended to help with attainment of a General Education Development credential or diploma, and are offered by an employee of the district appropriately credentialed for the course being offered. Allows a community college offering a GED preparation class provided at a worksite to limit admission to employees at that worksite.

CA A 1320 Fong (D)
Title: Workforce Development: Lifelong Learning Accounts
Status: Failed - Adjourned
Summary: Creates the Lifelong Learning Accounts Initiative Program, for the purpose of providing grants to employers and employees to be used to establish individual lifelong learning accounts for the deposit of funds to be used by those employees and employers for purposes related to lifelong education and training. Requires the Employment Development Department to establish a grant program and administer the program.

CA A 1707 Conway (R)
Title: Employment: Apprentice Training
Status: Failed - Adjourned
Summary: Makes non-substantive changes to existing law that makes the public policy of the state to promote apprenticeship as a form of on-the-job training when such training is cost effective.

CA A 1828 Cook (R)
Title: Correctional Peace Officer Standards and Training
Status: Failed - Adjourned
Summary: Creates the Commission on Correctional Peace Officer Standards and Training, which would succeed the Corrections Standards Authority as responsible for developing, approving and monitoring standards for the selection and training of state correctional peace officers and apprentices.

CA A 2004 Beall (D)
Title: Job Creation, Work Incentive, and Work Subsidy Programs
Status: Failed - Adjourned
Summary: Enacts the Civic Works Act of 2010. Requires the Department of Social Services to issue all-county letters or similar instructions to clarify eligibility criteria, and provide a framework for wage subsidy programs funded pursuant to the federal Emergency Contingency Fund for State Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Programs. Requires the department to be prepared to launch a civic works employment program and to encourage counties to develop related apprenticeship programs.

CA A 2393 Ammiano (D)
Title: Private Postsecondary Education Act of 2009
Status: Vetoed: 09/23/2010
Summary: Amends the Private Postsecondary Education Act of 2009 that requires private postsecondary educational institutions to annually report and publish statistics including job placement rates and to comply with various fair business practices and provides the preservation of certain claims and remedies of the former act. Provides the continuation of an action remedy. Defines graduates employed in the field for purposes of specified reporting requirements.

CA A 2637 Chesbro (D)
Title: Bay Pilots: Humboldt Bay
Status: Failed - Adjourned
Summary: Amends existing law that provides for the regulation and licensing of pilots. Authorizes a pilot licensed by the Humboldt Bay Harbor, Recreation, and Conservation District to perform pilotage for the bay to take any examination administered by a specified board upon the adoption of a related statement by that board regarding the pilot's experience. Establishes requirements for the pilot entering the pilot trainee training program.

CA A 2726 Lowenthal B (D)
Title: Employment Development Department: Career Centers
Status: Vetoed: 09/25/2010
Summary: Specifies that entrance into on-the-job training through an apprenticeship program approved by the Division of Apprenticeship Standards shall be considered placement into a job. Requires the State Workforce Investment Board and local boards to ensure that programs and services funded by the Workforce Investment Act directed to apprenticeship occupations work in coordination with one or more apprenticeship programs approved by the Division of Apprenticeship Standards.

CA AJR 45 Fong (D)
Title: Lifelong Learning Accounts
Status: Adopted: 09/14/2010
Summary: Urges the federal government to create and fund programs that encourage lifelong learning, such as Lifelong Learning Accounts within the state.

CA S 45 Padilla (D)
Title: Public Works: Payment of Prevailing Wage: Violations
Status: Vetoed: 10/11/2009
Summary: Provides that a contractor or subcontractor performing a public works project who is found by the Labor Commissioner to be in violation of the public works law, with the intent to defraud, for the first time, is ineligible to be on or be awarded a contract for a project for specified periods of time, with a prescribed exemption related to apprenticeship requirements. Provides that for a 2nd violation, the contractor or subcontractor shall be ineligible to bid or be awarded a contract.

CA S 405 Cogdill (R)
Title: Contractors: Fire Sprinkler Installation
Status: Failed
Summary: Requires any commercial or residential fire sprinkler installation project performed by a Class C-16 fire protection contractor to be under the direct and immediate supervision of a commercial or residential fire sprinkler supervisor. Requires fire protection contractors to implement a fire sprinkler installation training program for their sprinkler fitters and to file a description of the program with the State Fire Marshal. Provides that a violation by a contractor is grounds for disciplinary action.

CA S 477 Florez (D)
Title: Employment: Heat Illness Prevention
Status: Failed - Adjourned
Summary: Incorporates certain regulatory provisions concerning occupational health and safety standards for the prevention of heat related illness into statute. Specifies requirements for employers to provide employees access to shade when the temperature exceeds a certain amount and to implement designated high-heat procedures when the temperature equals or exceeds a certain amount. Prohibits an employer from allowing an employee or a supervisor to engage in outdoor work without receiving training.

CA S 599 Negrete McLeod (D)
Title: Workforce Development
Status: Enacted: 11/02/2009
Summary: Requires the successor agency to the Bureau for Private Postsecondary and Vocational Education to transmit school performance data from schools under its jurisdiction to the Postsecondary Education Commission. Provides, relative to Federal Stimulus Act workforce development program funds, that a local board may work with approved entities to design education and training to fill the needs of job seekers and employers. Relates to apprenticeships. Extends the Dental Corps Loan Repayment Program.

CA S 725 Hancock (D)
Title: Regional Occupational Centers: Apprenticeship Program
Status: Failed
Summary: Enacts the State Apprenticeship Preparation Program Act of 2009. Authorizes a regional occupational center or program to offer such program. Requires the approval and certification of such program using specified criteria. Requires collaboration to develop curriculum covering all aspects of the building trades and construction industry that meets specified requirements and standards, including state-approved joint labor-management and unilateral nonunion apprenticeship programs.

CA S 974 Steinberg (D)
Title: Income and Corporations Tax: Hiring and Career Credit
Status: Failed - Adjourned

Summary: Amends the Personal Income Tax and Corporation Tax laws. Authorizes a credit against those taxes for a business entity providing career technical education. Revises the definition of employee in the income tax laws which provide a credit within enterprise zones for hiring qualified employees to include certain ex-offenders. Removes employee residency requirements. Requires taxpayers to apply for, and obtain, the certification of an employee with a specified time period of the date of hire.

CA S 985 Dutton (R)
Title: Income Tax Credits: Education and Training
Status: Failed - Adjourned
Summary: Allows a tax credit under the Personal Income Tax Law and the Corporation Tax Law for a percentage of the amount of costs paid or incurred in connection with additional education and training for purposes of career advancement or retention. Deletes provisions relating to regulatory authority of the Public Utilities Commission over electrical corporations.

CA S 1397 Corbett (D)
Title: Apprenticeship Oversight
Status: Vetoed: 09/23/2010
Summary: Specifies that no 2 employee representatives on the State Apprenticeship Council may be from the same national or international labor organization. Modifies the schedule for the auditing of apprenticeship programs by the Division of Apprenticeship Standards. Relates to auditing of new or newly expanded building and construction trades apprenticeship programs. Prescribes requirements for an application by a building and construction trades program for approval of a new or expanded apprenticeship program.

COLORADO

CO H 1241 Casso (D)
Title: Register Fire Suppress Sprinkler Fitters
Status: Enacted: 06/07/2010
Summary: Prohibits a person from acting or advertising as a sprinkler fitter unless the person has registered with the state fire suppression administrator; provides that in order to register, a person shall pay a fee and demonstrate that he or she has successfully completed a sprinkler fitter apprenticeship program.

CONNECTICUT

CT H 5194 Green (D)
Title: Business Component to the Youth Services
Status: Failed
Summary: Concerns the inclusion of a business component to the youth services bureaus; increases employment and educational options for youth.

CT S 133 Joint General Law
Title: Apprentice to Journeymen and Contractor Ratios
Status: Enacted: 05/10/2010
Summary: Concerns apprentice to journeymen and contractor ratios; changes existing apprentice to journeymen and contractor hiring ratios for certain tradespersons, including electrical, plumbing, heating, piping and cooling, sprinkler fitter and sheet metal work apprentices.

DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

DC B 183 Brown K (D)
Title: Jobs Now Act
Status: Pending - Adjourned
Summary: Requires the Mayor to establish evening, weekend and summer adult career technical training for industry certification for District residents at the Phelps Architecture, Construction, and Engineering High School, at the Academy of Construction and Design at Cardozo Senior High School and at the Hospitality Public Charter School at Roosevelt High School in partnership with existing career technical education programs.

DC B 862 Brown M (I)
Title: Good Corporate Citizenship Business
Status: Pending - Adjourned
Summary: Amends Title 47 of the District of Columbia Official Code to include a new section of tax incentives for businesses that exceed LEED Gold Standards, provide paid time off for employee participation in tutoring or mentoring programs, provide employee wellness programs, provide employee tuition reimbursement or provide pro bono services to local charitable or governmental institutions.

GEORGIA

GA H 107 Geisinger (R)
Title: State Board Of Locksmiths
Status: Failed - Adjourned
Summary: Relates to professions; provides for legislative intent; provides for definitions; to create the State Board of Locksmiths; provides for the membership, duties, and powers of such board; provides for fees; provides for the licensing and registration of locksmith contractors, locksmiths, and apprentices; provides for qualifications for licensing and registration; provides for continuing education; provides for certain documentation and records.

HAWAII

HI H 21 Aquino (D)
Title: Small Businesses Training
Status: Failed - Adjourned
Summary: Requires business registrants with 10 or fewer anticipated employees to attend business management training courses.

HI H 716 Evans (D)
Title: Seizure First Aid
Status: Failed - Adjourned
Summary: Requires employers to educate employees regarding seizure first aid with information provided by DLIR.

HI H 1289 Rhoads (D)
Title: Apprenticeship and Procurement
Status: Failed - Adjourned
Summary: Requires all offerors and subcontractors for construction contracts subject to the state public procurement code, to maintain or participate in a bona fide, state-approved apprenticeship program at the time of general bidding.

HI H 2031 Nakashima (D)
Title: Contractors
Status: Failed - Adjourned
Summary: Increases from one to three the number of electrical or plumbing apprentices that may be employed on a construction job site for each licensed electrical or plumbing worker.

HI H 2430 Rhoads (D)
Title: Procurement
Status: Failed - Adjourned
Summary: Permits bidders and their subcontractors who are registered under an apprenticeship agreement with DLIR to benefit from a 5 percent reduction in their bid amount on contracts for \$250,000 or more.

HI H 2842 Say (D)
Title: Taxation
Status: Failed - Adjourned

Summary: Creates a tax credit for employers who fund continuing education for certain employees to improve their existing skills; limits the amount of employer contributions paid under the employment security Laws for the 2010 and 2011 calendar years even if the employer hires a certain number of additional employees.

HI H 2950 Awana (D)
Title: Electricians
Status: Failed - Adjourned
Summary: Reduces the minimum experience requirements to obtain licenses for certain types of electricians, and specifies the types of electricians a journey worker specialty electrician must train under.

HI S 1125 Takamine (D)
Title: Apprenticeship and Procurement
Status: Failed - Adjourned
Summary: Requires all offerors and subcontractors for construction contracts subject to the state public procurement code, to maintain or participate in a bona fide, state-approved apprenticeship program at the time of general bidding.

HI S 2061 Takamine (D)
Title: Procurement
Status: Failed - Adjourned
Summary: Permits bidders and their subcontractors who are registered under an apprenticeship agreement with Department of Labor and Industrial Relations to benefit from a 5% reduction in their bid amount on contracts for \$250,000 or more.

HI S 2248 Hanabusa (D)
Title: Taxation
Status: Failed - Adjourned
Summary: Creates a tax credit for employers who fund continuing education for certain employees to improve their existing skills; limits the amount of employer contributions paid under the employment security Laws for the 2010 and 2011 calendar years even if the employer hires a certain number of additional employees.

ILLINOIS

IL H 323 Sacia (R)
Title: Illinois Procurement Code
Status: Pending - Adjourned
Summary: Amends the Procurement Code. Provides that the requirement that a State construction contract responsible bidder and his or her subcontractors participate in applicable apprenticeship and training programs is limited to those trades that the bid specifies will be used on the project and that have apprenticeship or training programs. Changes the name of the federal entity that approves and accepts registration of the apprenticeship and training program.

IL H 624 Crespo (D)
Title: Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity
Status: Enacted: 08/10/2009
Summary: Amends the Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois. Relates to provisions governing training grants for skills in critical demand. Provides that no employee may be an unauthorized alien. Permits on-site grant monitoring visits to verify employment dates and wages. Requires applicants to certify employment at an Illinois facility and employee information. Authorizes audits.

IL H 801 Wait (R)
Title: Illinois Income Tax Act
Status: Pending - Adjourned
Summary: Amends the Illinois Income Tax Act. Reinstates the training expense credit for tax years ending on or after December 31, 2009 and on or before December 30, 2019. Increases the amount of the credit from 1.6% of

training expenses to 2% of training expenses. Allows a credit earned on or after December 31, 2009 to be carried forward.

IL H 3162 Cross (R)
Title: Training Expense Credit
Status: Pending - Adjourned
Summary: Amends the Illinois Income Tax Act. Reinstates the training expense credit for tax years ending on or after December 31, 2010 and on or before December 30, 2020. Increases the amount of the credit from 1.6% of training expenses to 2% of training expenses. Provides that the training expense credit earned on or after December 31, 2009 may be carried forward.

IL H 3846 Beiser (D)
Title: Local Government Construction Contract Act
Status: Pending - Adjourned
Summary: Creates the Local Government Construction Contract Act. Provides that a bidder on a construction contract with a unit of local government or school district and all of that bidder's subcontractors must participate in active apprenticeship and training programs approved by and registered with the United States Department of Labor's Bureau of Apprenticeship and Training for each of the trades of work contemplated under the awarded contract. Preempts home rule powers.

IL H 5248 Sacia (R)
Title: Procurement Code
Status: Pending - Adjourned
Summary: Amends the Illinois Procurement Code; provides that the requirement that a State construction contract responsible bidder and his or her subcontractors participate in applicable apprenticeship and training programs is limited to those trades that the bid specifies will be used on the project and that have apprenticeship or training programs; changes the name of the federal entity that approves and accepts registration of the apprenticeship and training programs.

IL H 5390 Howard (D)
Title: Felony Convictions
Status: Pending - Adjourned
Summary: Amends the Illinois Human Rights Act; makes it a civil rights violation for an employer, employment agency, or labor organization to inquire into or to use the fact of a felony conviction as a basis to refuse to hire, to segregate, or to act with respect to recruitment, hiring, promotion, renewal of employment, selection for training or apprenticeship, discharge, discipline, tenure or terms if more than 10 years have elapsed since the conviction.

IL H 5812 Senger (R)
Title: Income Tax Act
Status: Pending - Adjourned
Summary: Amends the Income Tax Act; reinstates the training expense credit for tax years ending on or after December 31, 2010 and on or before December 30, 2020; increases the amount of the credit for training expenses; provides that the training expense credit earned on or after December 31, 2010 may be carried forward.

IL S 138 Link (D)
Title: Capital Development Board Act
Status: Enacted: 08/25/2009
Summary: Amends the Capital Development Board Act. Specifies the requirements that must be met concerning building codes and inspections before a person may occupy a commercial building in certain municipalities and counties. Amends the Public Building Commission Act. Requires notice to the Capital Development Board of certain municipal and county building codes. Redefines the term building code. Includes persons qualified by a certified apprentice program within the definition of qualified inspector.

IL S 3026 Meeks (D)
Title: Procurement Code

Status: Pending - Adjourned
Summary: Amends the Illinois Procurement Code; provides that being considered a responsible bidder for purposes of State construction contracts, requires that the bidder satisfactorily show that any person used to perform the work subject to the bid has participated or is currently participating in federally approved and registered apprenticeship and training programs or craft training programs developed by the National Center for Construction Education and Research.

IL S 3075 Crotty (D)
Title: Municipal Code
Status: Pending - Adjourned
Summary: Amends the Illinois Municipal Code; provides that the corporate authorities of a non-home rule municipality may adopt a crime-free rental housing ordinance for the purpose of deterring crime in residential areas; provides that a crime-free rental housing ordinance may require a property owner to obtain a valid residential rental license from the municipality and to attend a training program or seminar concerning crime prevention.

IL S 3182 McCarter (R)
Title: Income Tax Act
Status: Pending - Adjourned
Summary: Amends the Income Tax Act; reinstates the training expense credit for tax years ending on or after December 31, 2010 and on or before December 30, 2020; increases the amount of the credit from 1.6% of training expenses to 2% of training expenses; provides that the training expense credit earned on or after December 31, 2010 may be carried forward.

IL S 3928 Hutchinson (D)
Title: Unemployment Insurance Act
Status: Pending - Adjourned
Summary: Amends the Unemployment Insurance Act; provides that eligible economically distressed workers enrolled or participating in economically distressed worker training may not be denied unemployment insurance benefits solely because they are attending training and eligible economically distressed workers approved for economically distressed worker training may not be denied unemployment insurance benefits for refusing to accept work, subject to certain conditions.

INDIANA

IN H 1282 Klinker (D)
Title: Lifelong Learning Account Pilot Program
Status: Failed - Adjourned
Summary: Relates to lifelong learning account pilot program; requires the Indiana education savings authority to establish and administer a lifelong learning account pilot program; provides that the annual household income of a participating individual may not exceed 300% of the federal income poverty level.

IOWA

IA D 1439 Beall
Title: Workforce Development Board
Status: Failed - Adjourned
Summary: Relates to Workforce Development Board; concerns apprenticeship and vocational rehabilitation ex-officio members.

IA D 1665 Beall
Title: Employer Education Act
Status: Failed - Adjourned
Summary: Relates to Employer Education Act.

IA H 400 State Government Committee
Title: Fire Protection System Installers

Status: Enacted: 04/24/2009
Summary: Relates to the licensing of persons installing fire protection systems; provides for apprentice sprinkler fitter and maintenance worker licensing; relates to evidence of a public liability insurance policy and surety bond; provides for provisional licensure.

IA H 2491 State Government Committee
Title: Fire Protection System Installer and Maintenance
Status: Failed
Summary: Relates to fire protection system installer and maintenance workers; revises apprenticeship requirements for trainees; eliminates references to a four year apprenticeship and instead requires completion of a fire protection apprenticeship program approved by the United States department of labor, or completion of two years of full time employment as a trainee; authorizes the fire marshal, by rule, may restrict the scope of work authorized by a license.

IA HSB 564 State Government Committee
Title: Fire Protection System Maintenance
Status: Failed - Adjourned
Summary: Provides that installation or fire protection system maintenance must be licensed as a fire sprinkler installer and maintenance worker; changes that designation to fire protection system installer and maintenance worker; revises apprenticeship requirements for trainees; eliminates references to a four year apprenticeship; requires completion of a fire protection apprenticeship program approved by the United States Department of Labor.

IA S 2022 Johnson (R)
Title: Training and Licensure Requirements
Status: Failed - Adjourned
Summary: Makes changes relating to training and licensure the Plumber, Mechanical Professional, and Contractor Licensing Act; currently, an apprentice working on the installation and repair of plumbing, HVAC, refrigeration, or hydronic systems must be enrolled in an applicable apprentice program that is registered with the United States department of labor's office of apprenticeship; eliminates the requirement that the program be registered with the federal government.

IA S 2355 State Government Committee
Title: Fire Protection System Installer
Status: Enacted: 03/10/2010
Summary: Changes the designation of a fire protection system installer and maintenance worker; revises apprenticeship requirements for trainees; eliminates references to an apprenticeship and instead requires completion of a fire protection apprenticeship program approved by the U.S. Department of Labor, or completion of a certain number of years of full time employment as a trainee.

IA SSB 3066 State Government Committee
Title: Fire Protection System Installer
Status: Failed - Adjourned
Summary: Changes that designation to fire protection system installer and maintenance worker; revises apprenticeship requirements for trainees; eliminates references to a four year apprenticeship; requires completion of a fire protection apprenticeship program approved by the United States Department of Labor.

KANSAS

KS H 2142 Commerce and Labor Committee
Title: Construction Code Training
Status: Enacted: 03/26/2009
Summary: Concerns licensure and continuing education requirements for certain trades and crafts; relates to code education relative to construction, maintenance and code update training provided by a community college, technical school or technical college; requires new licenses to identify the testing agency; requires distinctive notation on licenses renewed upon the basis of completed education; relates to electricians, heating, ventilation and air conditioning.

KENTUCKY

KY H 280 Denham (D)
Title: Economic Development
Status: Failed - Adjourned
Summary: Relates to economic development; increases the maximum amount of grants-in-aid to \$500,000; removes the requirement that an employee shall have been employed for the last 12 months preceding filing of an application for skills training; removes the requirement that a full-time employee shall have been employed by a qualified company for more than 250 work days; requires the Bluegrass State Skills Corporation to establish employee retention requirements for skills training investment credits.

KY H 295 Thompson (D)
Title: Building Inspectors
Status: Enacted: 04/26/2010
Summary: Relates to the Building Inspectors' Financial Incentive Training Program Fund; changes the annual funding for the Building Inspectors' Financial Incentive Training Program from \$150,000 to \$125,000; requires that if the fund reaches a balance exceeding \$125,000, funds annually resulting from plan review fees in excess of \$125,000 shall be used solely for the operating costs of the Office of Housing, Buildings, and Construction's building inspection program.

LOUISIANA

LA H 1047 St. Germain (D)
Title: Bail Bonds
Status: Enacted: 06/29/2010
Summary: Creates the Bail Bond Apprenticeship Program and provides for qualifications and requirements to complete the program; provides that the program shall be available to persons who meet current licensing requirements as a bail producer and who do not have a felony conviction and that apprentices shall complete a prelicensing course during the apprenticeship; requires specified supervised work experience.

LA S 301 Walsworth (R)
Title: Incumbent Worker Training Program
Status: Enacted: 06/30/2010
Summary: Provides relative to the Incumbent Worker Training Program; provides in the assessment year following a year in which amounts were appropriated from the Incumbent Worker Training Account for use in the state general fund, assessments shall not include the shortfall taken from the account in the previous year for use in the general fund.

LA S 535 Nevers (D)
Title: Workforce Development
Status: Failed - Adjourned
Summary: Provides that certification cards be issued to those who successfully complete a state approved electrical apprenticeship program approved by the state Workforce Commission.

LA S 537 Nevers (D)
Title: Workforce Commission
Status: Enacted: 06/30/2010
Summary: Provides relative to apprentices; provides for the membership and workings of the apprenticeship council in the Office of Apprenticeship; provides for the requirements of a valid apprenticeship agreement.

LA S 612 Dorsey (D)
Title: Workforce Development
Status: Failed - Adjourned
Summary: Provides regulations and procedures for any public or private entity which receives federal funds from the state; relates to workforce development.

MAINE
