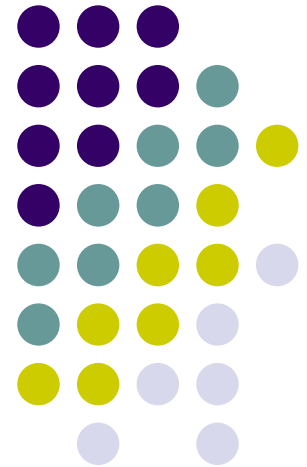

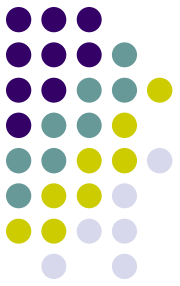




# Refresh Cycle

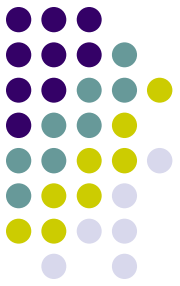
- Lexmark 522 and 1855 printer models had been in the environment between 5 – 8 years
  - Printers needed to be replaced in both the Capitol and District offices
- House and Senate historically provide the copiers and fax machines
- After thorough testing and evaluation, council determined that we could support MFPs that offered printing, copying, faxing and scanning

# Lexmark T644 with 4600 scanner attachment

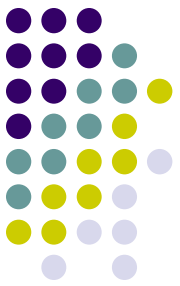


- Copying
  - Low and high volume document copying
  - Black and white output only, no color
- Printing
  - 50 pages a minute
- Scan to Email
  - Can scan documents and email as attachments to one or more email recipients
- Faxing
  - Currently walk-up faxing only

# Capitol and District Office Deploy Project



- Every office receives at least one MFP device
  - If an office had more than one printer, they receive one MFP and the remaining devices are T644 printers
- Capitol complex – 400 MFPs, 190 printers
  - Average 20 devices a day, finished in 8 weeks
- District offices – 200 MFPs
  - Average 4 offices a day, will be complete in about 18 weeks



# What made it successful?

- Worked closely with our clients to determine their needs
- TESTED, TESTED, TESTED!
- Worked closely with our vendor
  - Onsite during 1st week of installations
  - Weekly meetings throughout installation phase
- Required "pre-installation" training/demo classes, one staff member from each office
- One-on-one follow-up visits with all offices to ensure their comfort level
- Teamwork between IS departments
