

Automation of Journal Production

The journal typically is the official chronological record of the actions and proceedings of a legislative chamber, and many steps must be taken to produce it. Information must be compiled, proofed and corrected before the document is ready for publication. Many legislatures are streamlining journal production through automation.

How is the journal compiled? Because the journal is an important legislative document, legislatures have staff who are responsible for its production. Table 06-7.61 illustrates the type—full-time, part-time or session only—and number of staff who work on the journal.

The methods by which legislatures compile their journals have changed over the years—from handwritten to typewritten to computer generated. Table 06-7.62 highlights the compilation processes that currently are used. In 1991, only 12 legislative assemblies used personal computers for journal production. Today, 85 chambers compile their journals on personal computers (see table 06-7.63). More than three-fourths of legislative assemblies developed their journal compilation processes in-house (see table 06-7.64). Table 06-7.65 highlights the computer programs used to generate the journal. Tables 06-7.66 through 06-7.90 provide information on how specific journal items are compiled.

The journal is considered to be the official record of legislative action for almost every legislative body, but only 12 chambers have automated methods to catch discrepancies between the bill status or history system and the journal (see table 06-7.91).

How is it published? The formats in which a journal may be published vary; they may be preliminary or permanent, printed or electronic. Seventy-five chambers produce a daily journal (see table 06-7.92), and 68 legislative assemblies post their daily journal on the Internet (see table 06-7.93). In 63 legislative bodies, the Internet version of the daily journal is searchable (see table 06-7.94); Table 06-7.95 highlights by what it can be searched.

Ninety-four chambers produce a final bound journal (see table 06-7.96), but only 41 legislative assemblies post the final journal on the Internet (see table 06-7.97). In 38 chambers, the Internet version of the final journal is searchable (see table 06-7.98); table 06-7.99 highlights by what it can be searched.

In the House, staff provided technical and functional specifications, then the chamber contracted with Digital Equipment Corporation to develop the automated system.
3. Illinois. Both chambers also used consultants.
4. Louisiana. The House uses a custom application software that combines WordPerfect software with language and text developed in-house. In addition, a Daktronics voting system captures votes, which are converted to a customized output for WordPerfect.
5. Maine. In the Senate, calendar software creates an original Word document. The journal clerk adds to the Word document to create the journal.
6. Texas. The Senate also uses a programmable formatting system.
7. Virginia. The House compiles the journal using a manual cut-and-paste method.
8. Wisconsin. In 1992, the Senate hired Anderson Consulting to revamp the bill drafting, tracking and document creation process; it began using the new system in 1994.
