

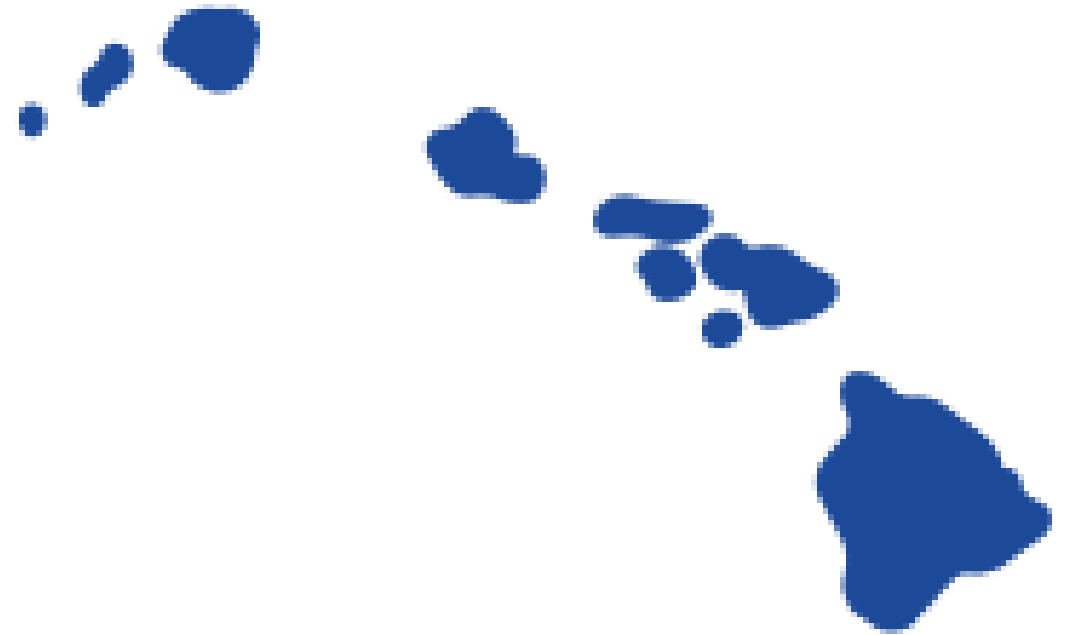

Hawaii Reapportionment Commission

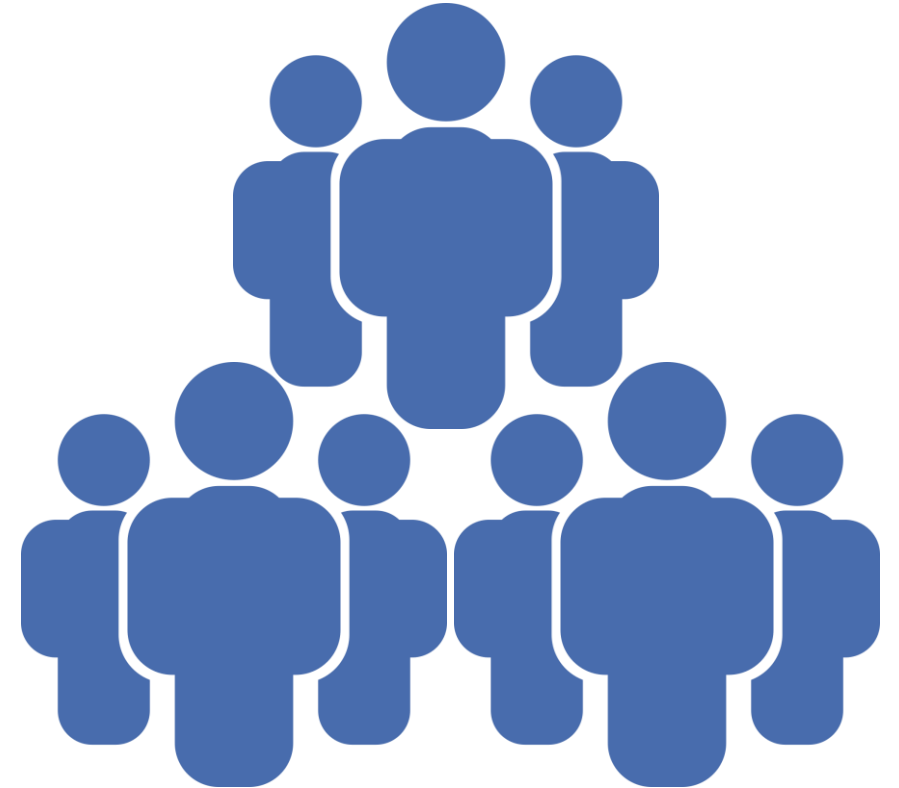
- Created in 1968 by the Hawaii State Constitution as a Legislature-appointed citizen commission
- Purpose:
 1. Apportion seats
 2. Redistrict



Hawaii Reapportionment Commission

Composition: **9 members**

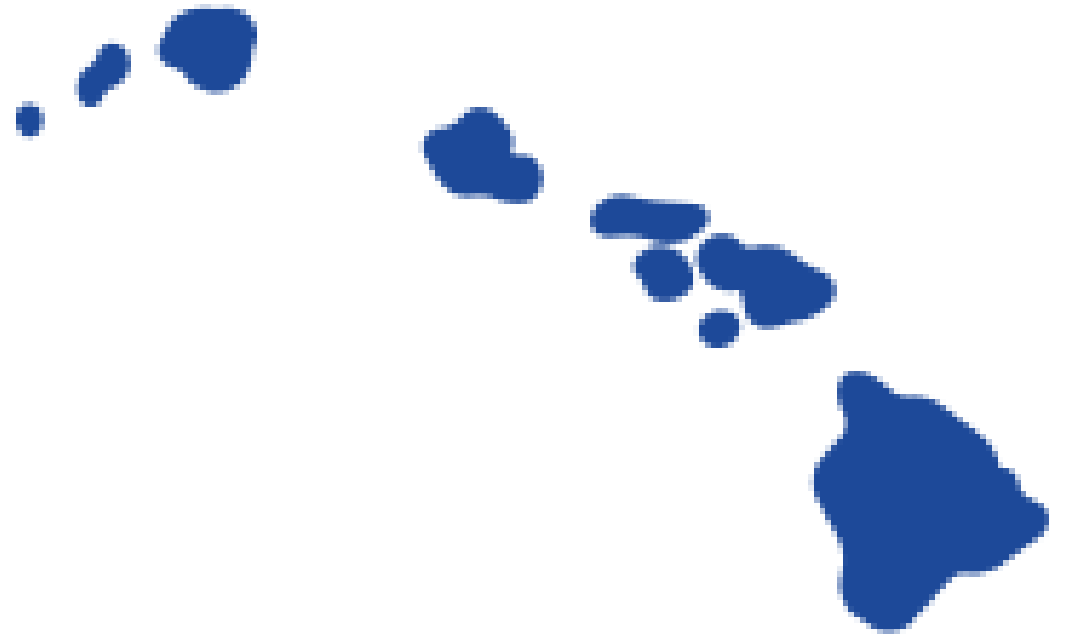
- 2 - Senate Majority
- 2 - Senate Minority
- 2 - House Majority
- 2 - House Minority
- 1 - Chair



Hawaii Reapportionment Commission

Advisory Council members are appointed for each of the four counties to assist and advise the Commission

- 4 – Oahu
- 4 – Kauai
- 4 – Maui
- 4 – Hawaii



Hawaii Reapportionment Commission

- Schedule:
 - Convene on or before **March 1**
 - Concludes **150 days** later
- Extension sought by Attorney General
