\*\*The Standing Committees will identify priority state-federal issues, consistent with NCSL policy, and major state issues for the coming year. The NCSL Executive Committee will review the issues identified by each Standing Committee and will then adopt the Conference's priority issues for 2017 during its January meeting.

**NCSL's By-Laws, Article XI, Section 6**

Under NCSL's By-Laws, Article XI, Section 6, at the start of the biennium, the Executive Committee is required to establish the state federal priorities and major state issues with input from the standing committees, task forces of the Executive Committee, the Conference's officers, members of the Executive Committee and the Executive Director. These state federal priorities and major state issues shall serve to guide the Conference's representation before the federal government, in standing committees and meeting programming and grant funded research.
