of jobs paying less than \$20 per hour will be impacted by automation.

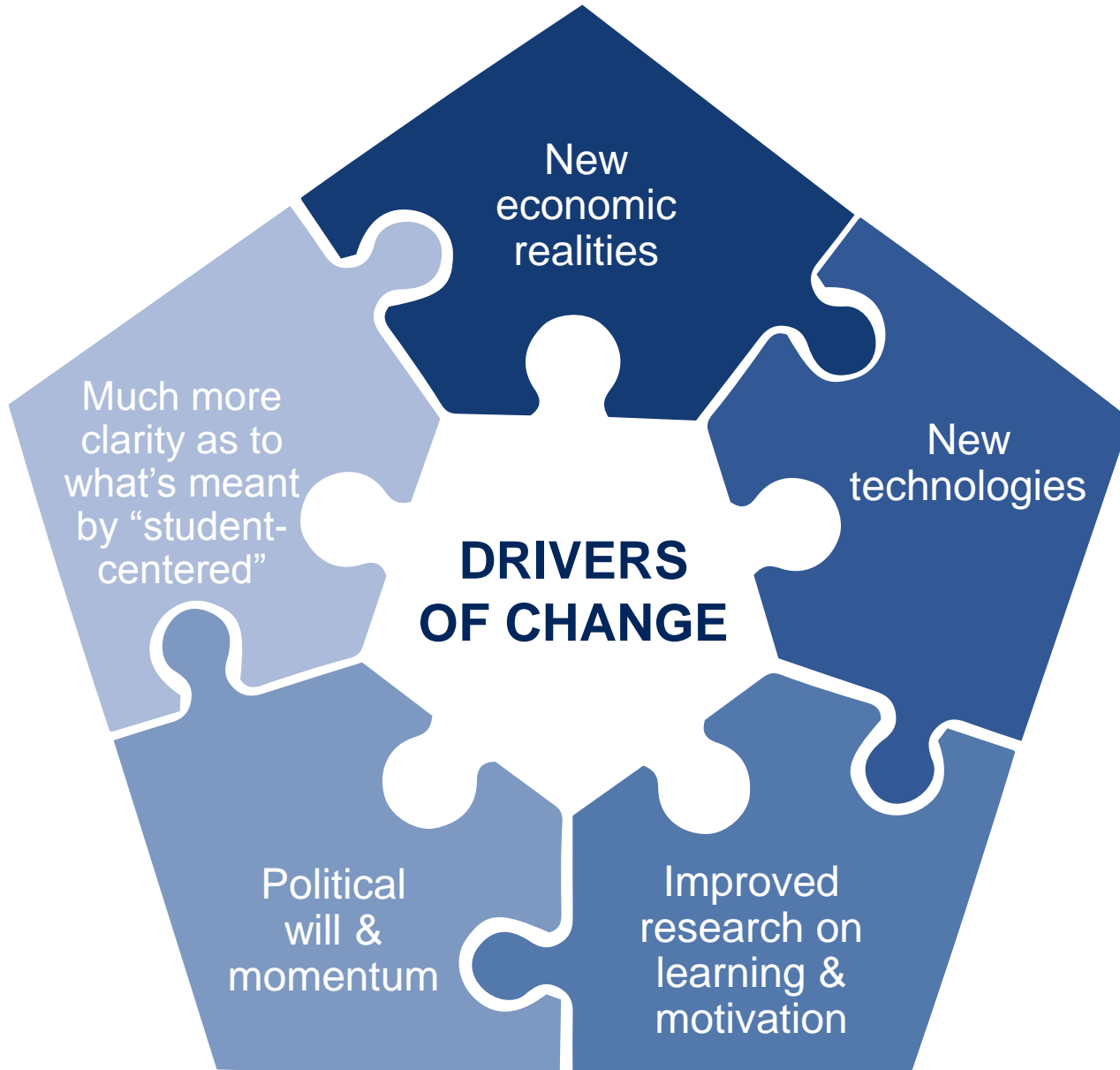


More than
