The Great Crew Change

- 71% of the workforce in Oil and Gas is 50 years of age or older
- 50% of geoscientists and engineers in the O&G industry will retire by the year 2018
- 70% of current petroleum engineering and geoscientist graduates globally are from Asia and Russia
- 90% of senior executives interviewed at 22 top O&G companies called the talent shortage one of the top 3 issues that their company faces
