Resource Plan and Baseload Fleet Transition



Prairie Island

- 1936 – Federal government recognized Prairie Island Indian Community reservation
- 1968 – Prairie Island Nuclear Plant construction begins
- 1973/1974 – Prairie Island Nuclear Plant began operation
- 1990 – Dry cask storage application submitted to NRC
- 1994 – 17 dry casks approved; Commitment to develop renewable energy sources
- 2003 – Settlement reached for additional dry casks
- 2008 – Partnership on long term storage resolution
- 2017 – Partnership for net zero community utilizing renewable development funds

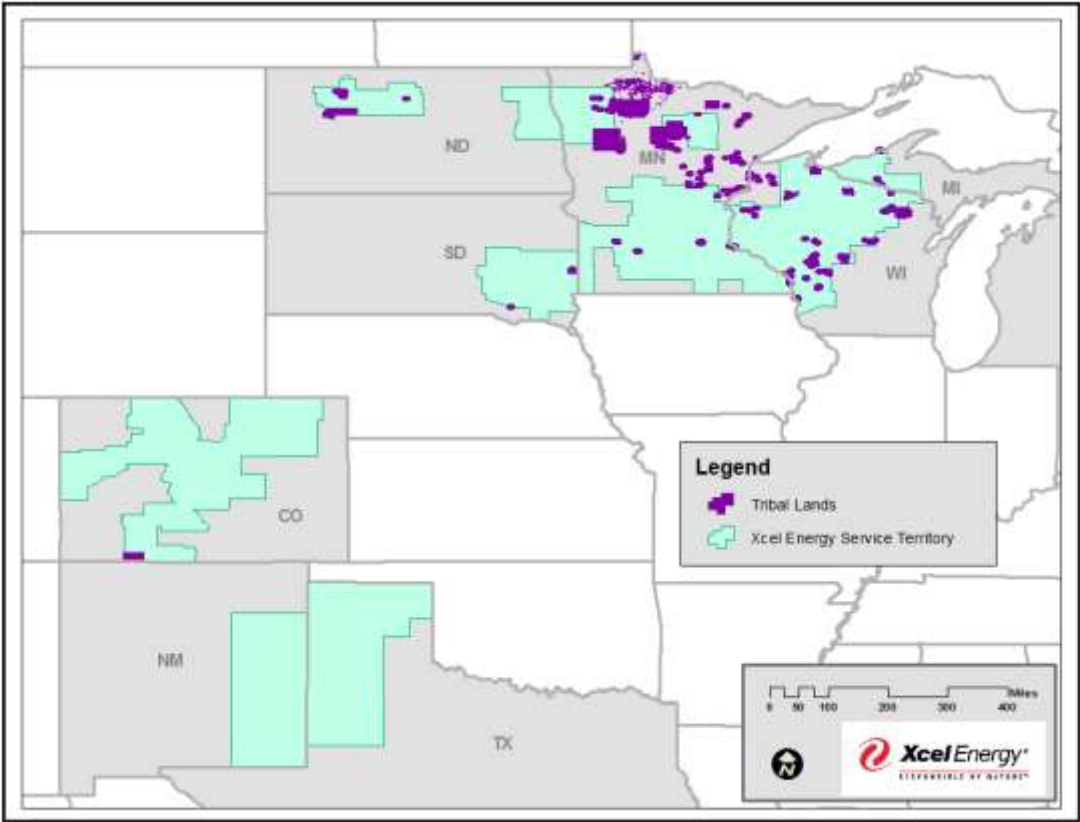


KODA Energy
