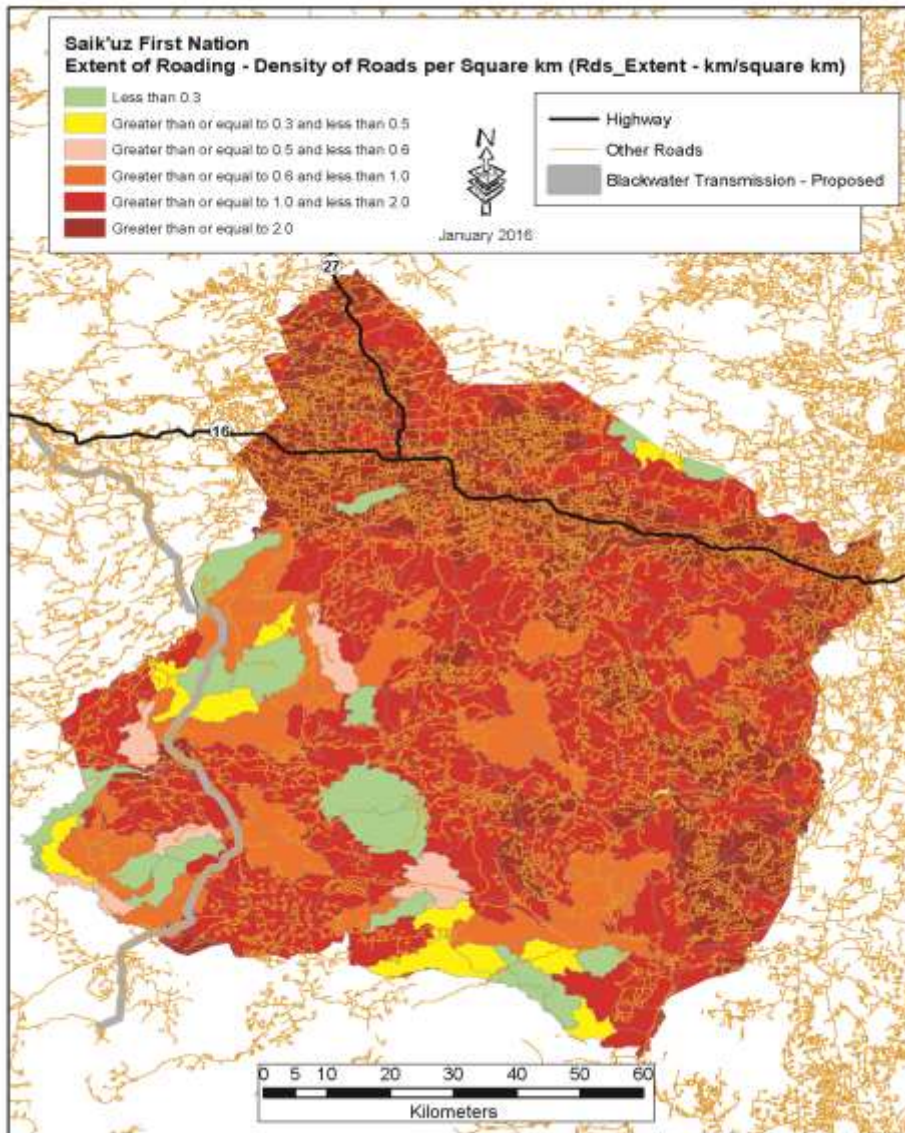

Saik'uz First Nation - Impacts



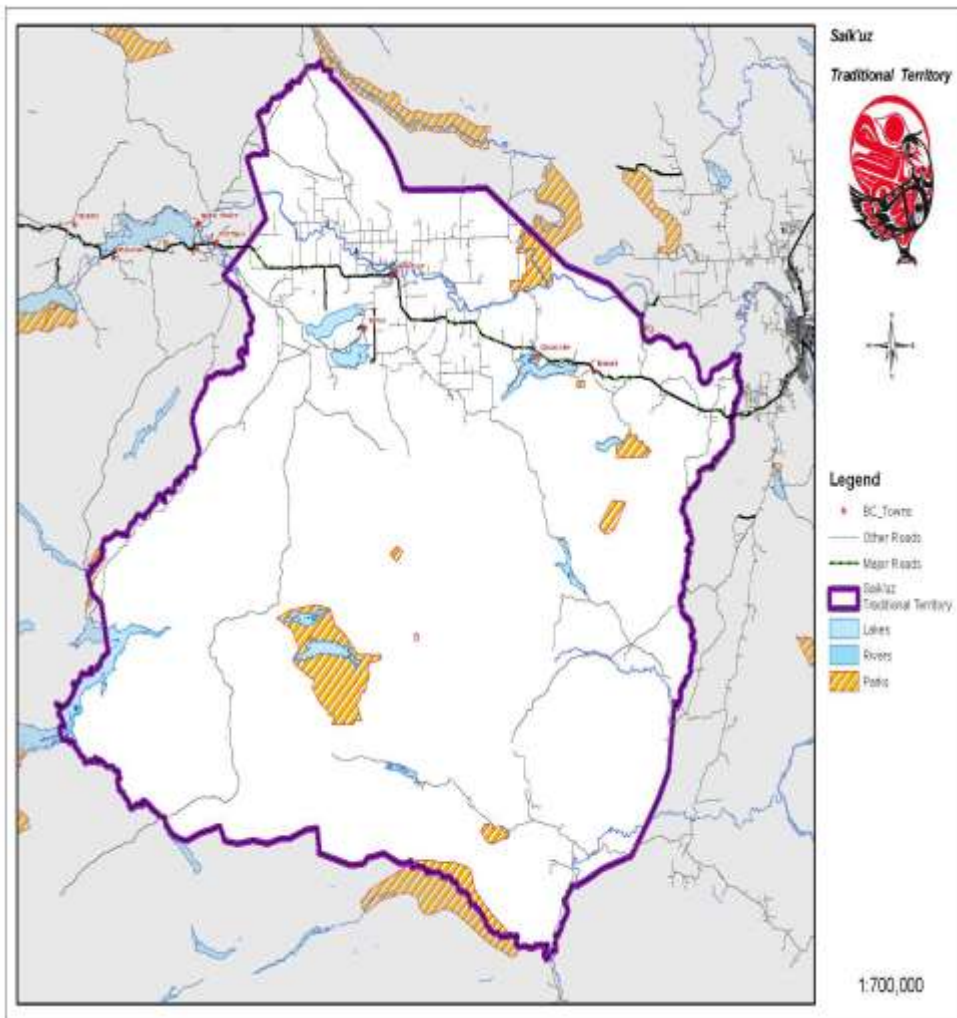
Example:

Territory impacts – road density over thresholds for grizzly bear, moose, caribou.

82% of community still use our land base for hunting, fishing, gathering, etc.

Future work:

Restoration of land & water for future generations to use territory.



Natural Gas Projects:

- ✓ 1 of 16 First Nations on PTP – signed 2008; FNLP >>Chevron
- ✓ 1 of 22 First Nations on TC-CGLP 2014; Shell

Oil Projects:

Enbridge Northern Gateway – no support

- respect our right to say “no” to projects that threaten our lands, waters, and resources

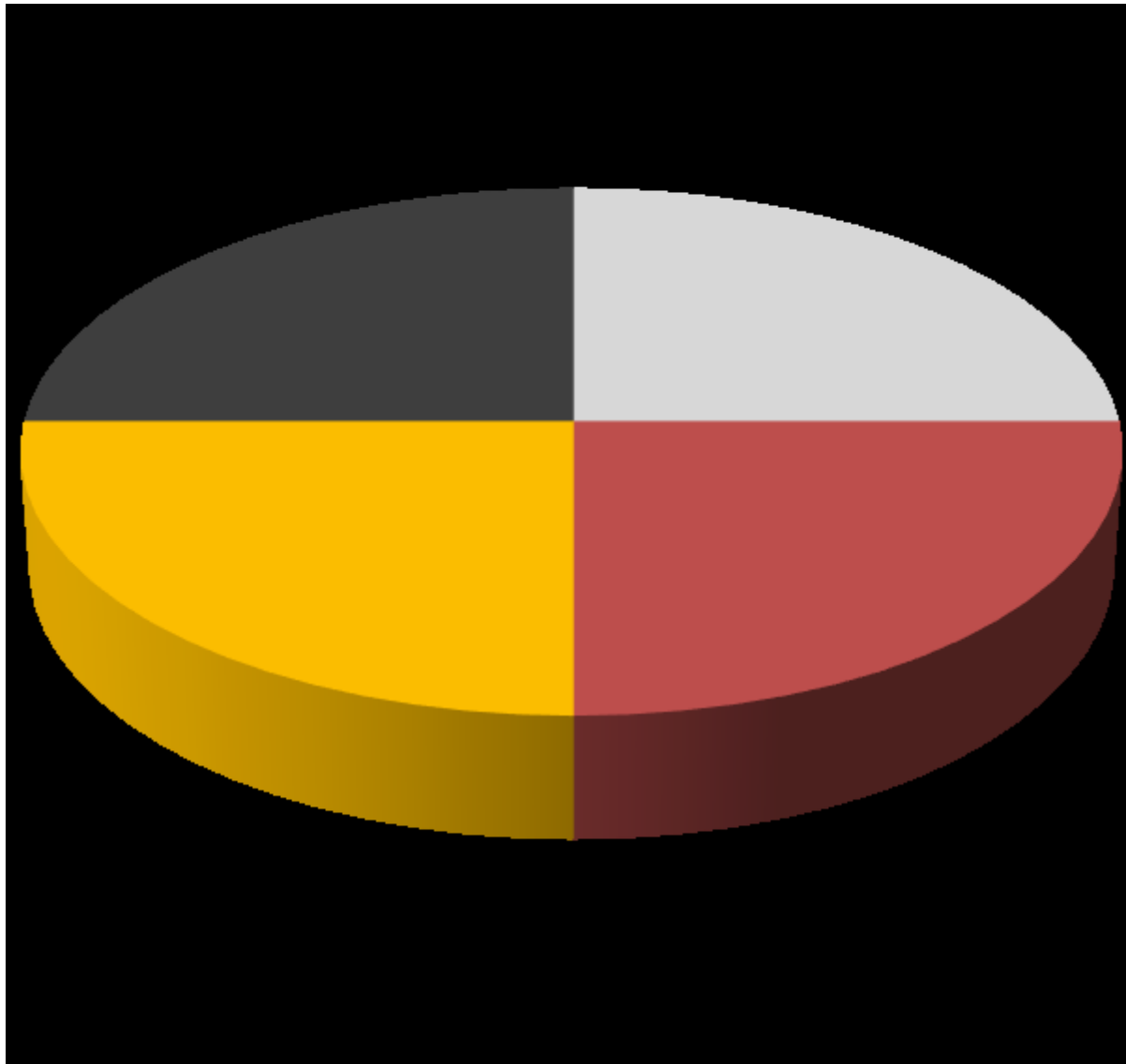
Agreements with BC 2015

- G2G package – 3 G2G Agreements:
 - 1 Pipeline Benefit Agreement with BC
 - 2 Collaboration Agreement (CA)
 - 2 working groups – *Leadership Table* and *Collaboration Working Group*
 - 3 Environmental and Socio-Cultural Initiatives Agreement (ESCIA)
 - 2 working groups – *Environmental* and *Socio-Cultural*
