# Transportation Practices

New DOE Order 460.2B will specifically require compliance with the practices.

- Set of standards for planning and executing offsite shipments of radioactive materials.
- A standardized process and framework for interaction.

DOE organizations are responsible for implementing these practices, as well as applicable agreements with State, Tribal, or local authorities.

- Emergency Planning
- Projected Shipment Planning Information
- Routing
- Security

- Shipment Prenotification
- Transportation Operational Contingencies
- Tracking
- Inspections



- Safe Parking
- Emergency Notification
- Emergency Response
- Recovery and Cleanup



# Summary

- Transportation practices provide a manual for safe, secure, efficient and consistent transportation throughout the Department of Energy.
- The last ad hoc Working Group meeting will be held in February.
- These practices will be reviewed by an internal DOE working group on transportation operations.
- Final rule is anticipated in the Q4 of FY16.
