NCSL Transportation Bill-Tracking Databases

NCSL partners with State Net to bring you the most up-to-date and comprehensive 50-state bill-tracking information available anywhere. NCSL regularly updates these databases of transportation-related legislation introduced in the states and the District of Columbia. The databases are publicly accessible and searchable by state, topic, keyword and status (e.g., pending, enacted, failed).

NCSL Traffic Safety Database

NCSL works in cooperation with the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration to track traffic safety bills. Topics include aggressive driving, automated enforcement and photo monitoring, child passenger protection, distracted driving, driver's licensing, impaired driving, motorcycle safety, pedestrian and bicycle safety, school bus safety, seatbelts and occupant protection, senior drivers, slow-medium speed vehicles, speed limits and teen drivers. NCSL provides up-to-date information about legislation that aims to improve transportation access and mobility for people who have challenges accessing transportation options due to income, disability or age. Topics include key populations such as people with disabilities and older adults, councils that aim to coordinate transportation programs across agencies and providers, special transit and paratransit, non-emergency medical transportation, fee and fare waivers, volunteer drivers and more.
