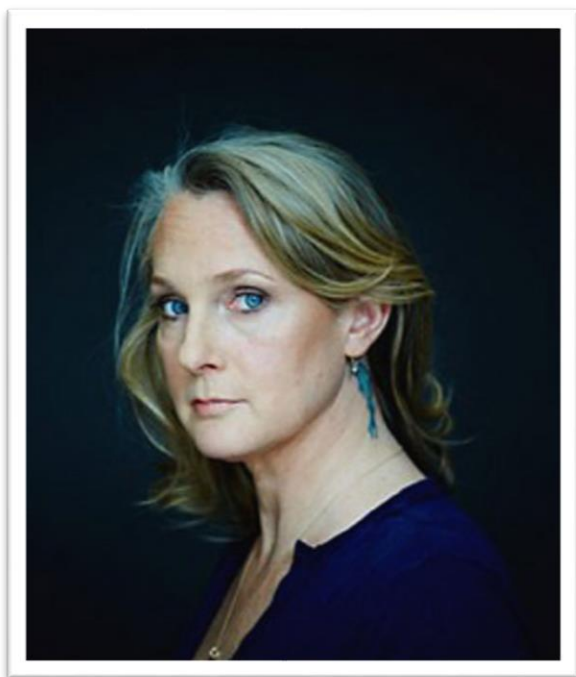




Corrections Reflections: A Conversation with Piper Kerman
