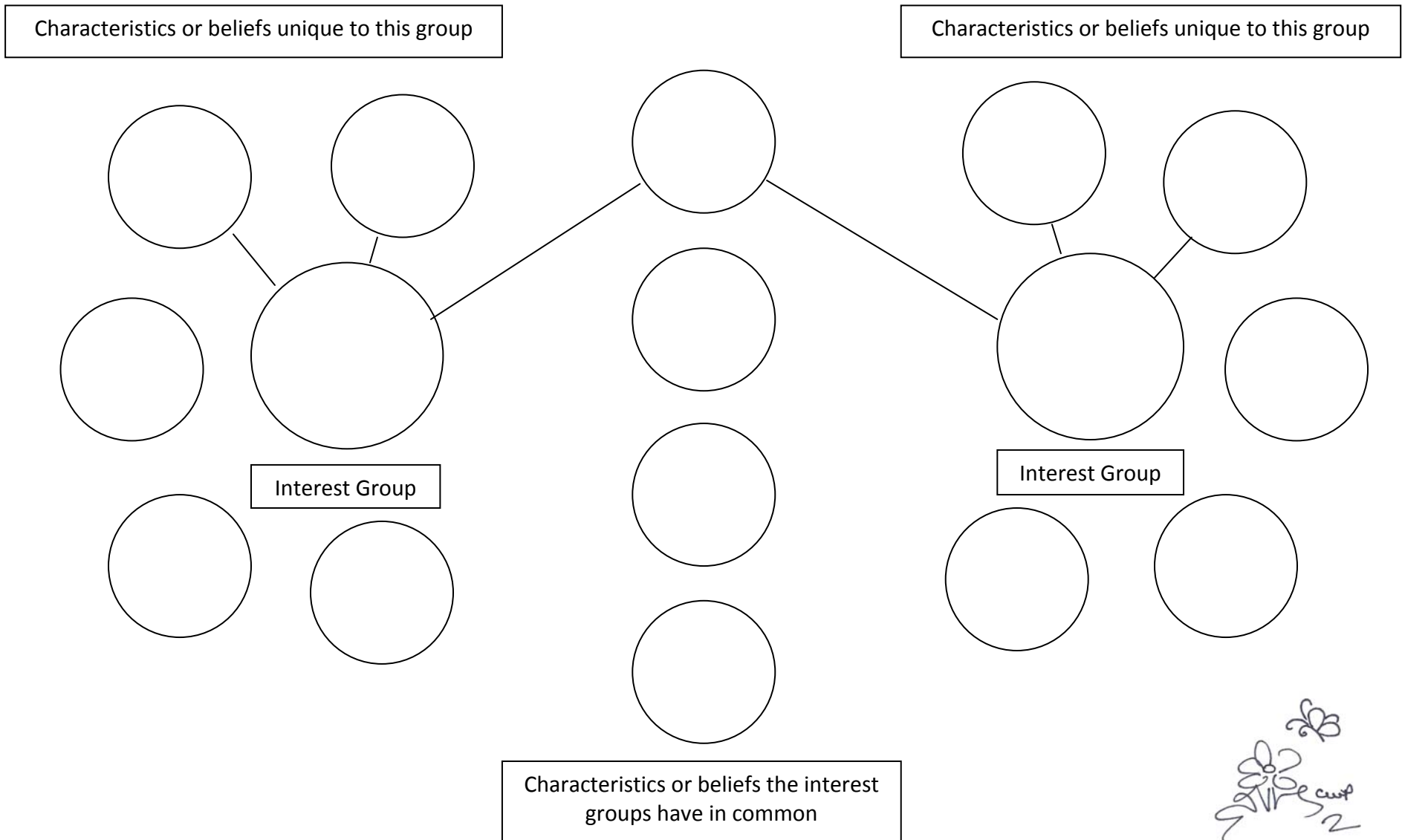


Making Comparisons between Interest Groups
