Overview of 2015 legislation

- **2,355** election-related bills have been ***introduced***
- **241** bills in 45 states have been ***enacted***
- **17** bills in 7 states have been ***vetoed***



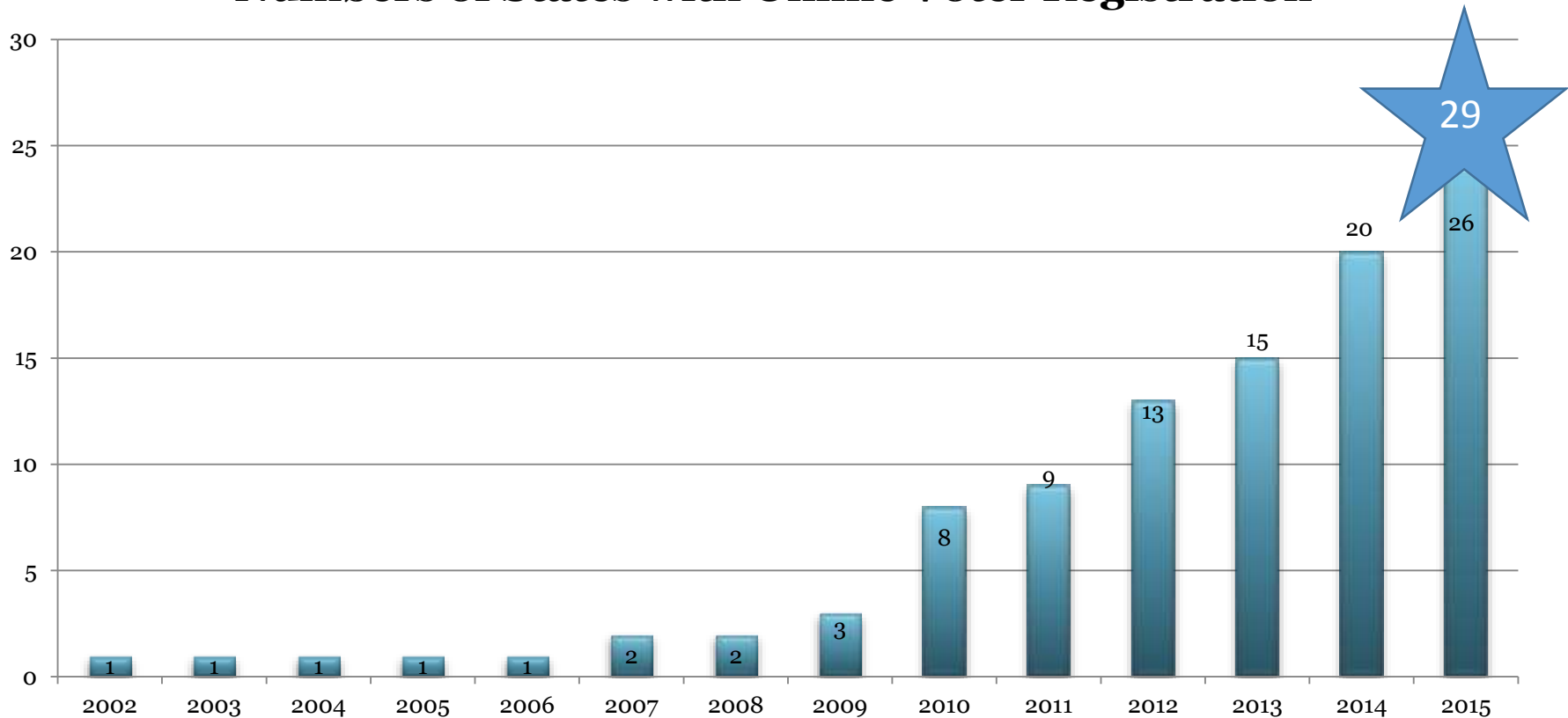
Trends

- Voter ID way down
- 2016 Prep for the Presidential

Voter ID way down

- 115 bills in 34 states introduced
- Only 8 bills in 4 states enacted
 - NC, TX & VA loosened requirements somewhat
 - ND tightened requirements.
- Down compared to previous years:
 - 2013—15 bills in 10 states
 - 2012—18 bills in 13 states

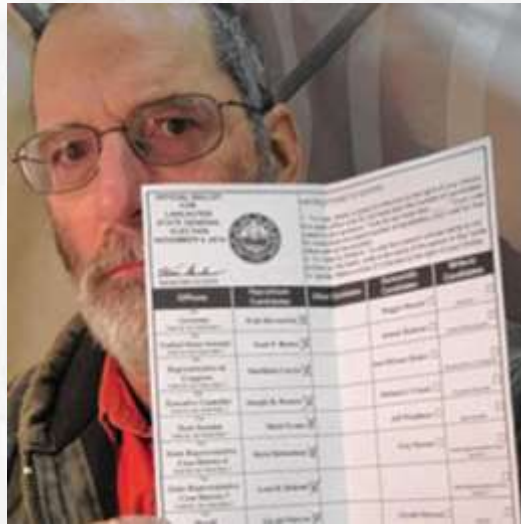


2016 Prep for the Presidential
