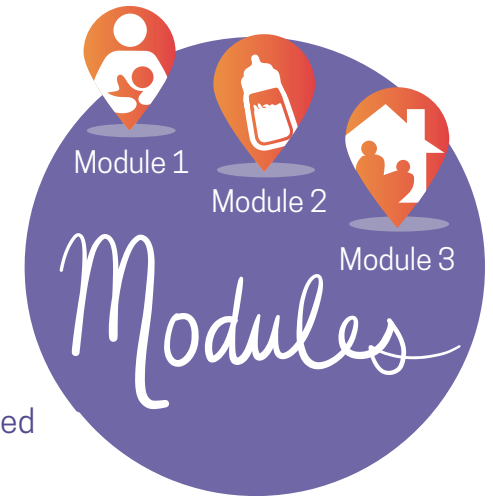

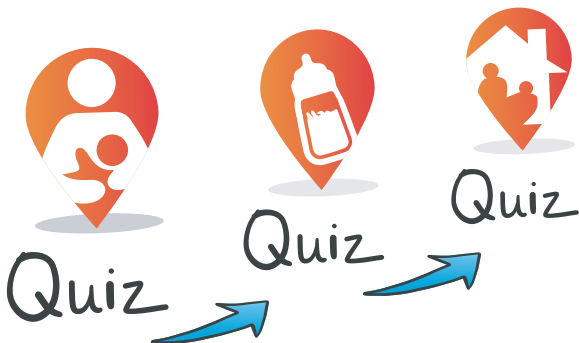

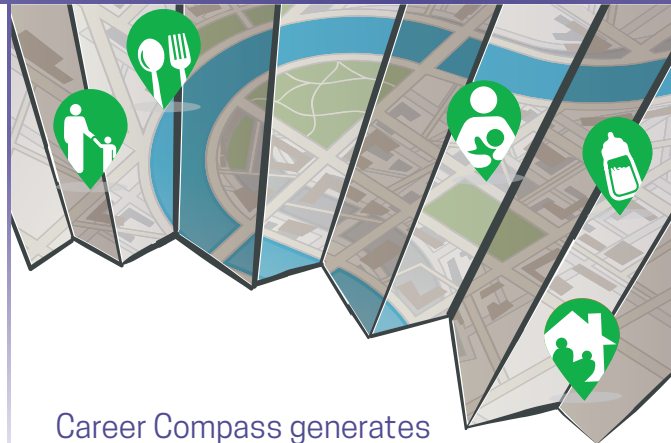
Based on knowledge gaps, FSPs are guided to modules that will fill those gaps.



FSPs take specific modules for targeted learning.



FSPs take a quiz that corresponds to each module, and newly-learned skills are transferred to MySkillsMap.



Career Compass generates updates and shows progress on MySkillsMap.

FSPs take the National Certification Exam when they are ready.



When FSPs pass the Certification Exam (80%+), they receive their National Certification.
