

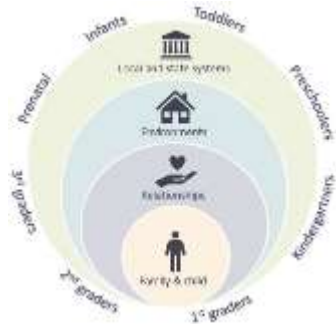


Early Childhood Fellows Chapter 3 Recap
