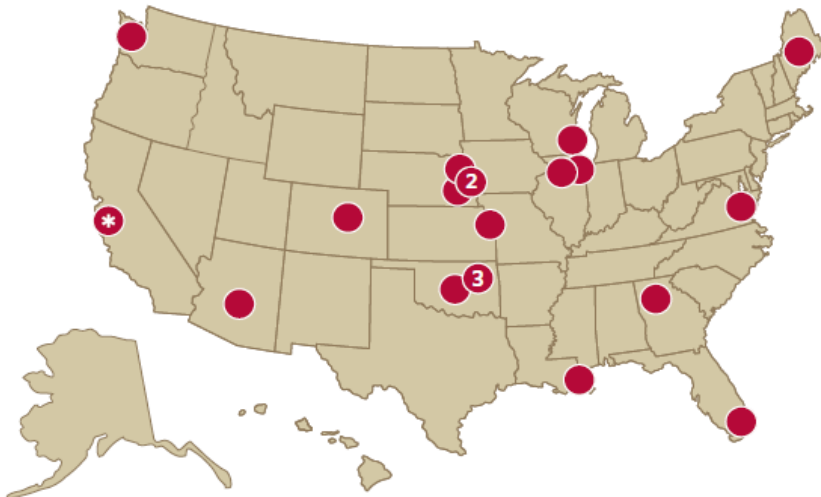

Basic Facts about Educare Denver

- Year Opened: 2007
- Location: Historic Clayton campus in northeast Denver
- Number of Children and Families Served: 112
 - Prenatal services - Weekly home visits for pregnant women and newborns
 - Part- and extended-day preschool – Infant, toddler and preschool-aged children
 - Combination of part-day preschool and bi-monthly home visits for toddlers and families
 - Home-based Early Head Start
- Funding: Parent fees, Colorado Child Care Assistance Program, federal Head Start/Early Head Start, Denver Public Schools (Colorado Preschool Program), private philanthropy, in-kind donations
- Partners: The Chambers Family Fund, Clayton Early Learning, Denver Public Schools, the State of Colorado
