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**2013 Prevailing Wage Legislation**

Thirty-one states considered legislation related to prevailing wage during the 2013 legislative session, with a total of 288 bills introduced. Eleven state legislatures passed laws; of those, 27 bills in ten states were signed into law, while six bills were vetoed.

Enactments included expansion of record-keeping requirements, use of design/build or construction manager/general contractor project delivery methods, penalties for prevailing wage violations, and changes to bidding processes for public works projects.

**ALABAMA**

AL H 107 - Williams J (R)

Title: State Contracts

Summary: Relates to state contracts; prevents the state or any political subdivision of the state from using the Davis-Bacon prevailing wage provisions in contracts. 05/07/2013 Indefinitely postponed.

**Arkansas**

AR H 1151 - Douglas D (R)

Title: Prevailing Wage Law

Summary: Repeals the Arkansas prevailing wage law and to provide flexibility to cities and counties for capital construction projects. 01/28/2013 To House Committee on Public Health, Welfare and Labor.

**California**

CA A 603 - Cooley (D)

Title: Public Contracts: Design-Build: Capitol Connector

Summary: Authorizes the Capitol Southeast Connector Joint Powers Authority to utilize the design-build procurement for the Southwest Connector Project in Sacramento County, subject to authorization. Requires a transportation entity awarding a contract for a public works project, to reimburse the Department of Industrial Relations for cost of performing prevailing wage monitoring and enforcement of public works project. Requires the moneys to be deposited in a specified fund. 04/22/2013 In Assembly Committee on Transportation: Not heard.

CA S 785 - Wolk (D)

Title: Design-Build

Summary: Repeals certain authorizations and enacts provisions that would authorize the Department of General Services, the Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation, and certain local agencies to use the design-build procurement process for specified public works. Provides that specified information is exempt from the Public Records Act. Requires specified moneys to be deposited into the State Public Works Enforcement Fund. 05/24/2013 In Senate. From third reading. To Inactive File.

CA A 76 - Assembly Budget Committee

Title: State Government

Summary: Relates to private postsecondary institutions, public education facilities bonding, electronic public records, public body meetings, state mandates funding, capitol area funding and public works, trauma center grants, agency agreements for services and materials, an agency marketplace program for procurement, agency personnel audits and reimbursement, state civil service revisions, board or commission member compensation, occupational safety, public works, state contracting, and emergency management. 06/18/2013 To Governor. 06/27/2013 Vetoed by Governor.

CA S 71 - Senate Budget & Fiscal Review Committee

Title: State Government

Summary: Relates to private postsecondary institutions, public education facilities bonding, public body meetings, state mandates funding, capitol area funding and public works, trauma center grants, agency services and materials, an agency marketplace procurement program, agency personnel audits and reimbursement, state civil service revisions, board or commission member compensation, occupational safety, law enforcement domestic violence response, public works, state contracting, and emergency management. 06/27/2013 Signed by Governor. Chaptered by Secretary of State. Chapter No. 28

CA A 195 - Hall (D)

Title: Counties: Construction Projects: Design-Build

Summary: Extends provisions of existing law that authorizes counties to use alternative procedures, known as design-build, for bidding on specified types of construction projects in the county in excess of a specified amount, in accordance with specified procedures, and provides that the procedures include a requirement for contracts awarded after a certain date that a county board of supervisors pay a fee into the State Public Works Enforcement Fund. 08/19/2013 Signed by Governor. Chaptered by Secretary of State. Chapter No. 121

CA S 776 - Corbett (D)

Title: Public Works: Prevailing Wage Rates: Credits

Summary: Makes changes to provisions specifying that certain employer payments are a credit against an obligation to pay the general prevailing rate of per diem wages, including certain benefits payments and payments to the Apprenticeship Council. Provides the conditions under which the employer may take credit for the payments. Prohibits credit from being granted for payments made to enforce laws related to public works if those payments are not required by a collective bargaining agreement. 08/27/2013 Signed by Governor. Chaptered by Secretary of State. Chapter No. 169

CA S 1 - Steinberg (D)

Title: Sustainable Communities Investment Authority

Summary: Authorizes certain public entities of a Sustainable Communities Investment Area to form a Sustainable Communities Investment Authority to carry out the Community Redevelopment Law. Provides for tax increment funding receipt under certain economic development and planning criteria. Establishes prequalification requirements for receipt of funding. Requires monitoring and enforcement of prevailing wage requirements within the area. Excludes certain types of farmland. 09/12/2013 In Senate. To Inactive File.

CA A 454 - Dickinson (D)

Title: Worker's Compensation Benefits: Prevailing Wages

Summary: Provides that, for purposes of determining temporary disability, temporary total disability, permanent total disability, and permanent partial disability, the amount of workers' comp benefits for a worker who is injured while performing work under a contract requiring a federal, state, county, city, or city and county prevailing wage requirement and who was paid a wage below the applicable prevailing wage for that work is to be calculated using the applicable prevailing wage, which is to be determined. 10/13/2013 Vetoed by Governor.

CA S 615 - Galgiani (D)

Title: Public Works: Prevailing Wages

Summary: Expands the definition of public works for purposes of provisions relating to the prevailing rate of per diem wages, to also include any construction, alteration, demolition, installation, or repair work done under private contract on a hospital or health care facility project when the project is paid for in whole or in part with the proceeds of conduit revenue bonds that were issued on or after a specified date. 10/13/2013 Vetoed by Governor.

CA A 797 - Gordon (D)

Title: Transit Districts: Contracts

Summary: Authorizes the Santa Clara County Valley Transportation Authority and the San Mateo County Transit District to utilize the Construction Manager/General Contractor project delivery contract method for transit projects within their jurisdictions. Requires the Authority or the district to reimburse the Department of Industrial Relations for costs of performing wage monitoring and enforcement on projects using such contracting methods. Requires those funds to be for enforcement of prevailing wage requirements. 09/20/2013 Signed by Governor. Chaptered by Secretary of State. Chapter No. 320

CA A 401 - Daly (D)

Title: Transportation: Design-Build: Highways

Summary: Authorizes the Department of Transportation to utilize design-build procurement for projects on the state highway system, based on either best value or lowest responsible bid. Authorizes regional transportation agencies to utilize such procurement for projects. Provides such authorizations do not include construction inspection services for highway- and expressway-related projects. Requires services to be performed by the Department. Requires reimbursement for prevailing wage monitoring and enforcement. 10/05/2013 Signed by Governor. Chaptered by Secretary of State. Chapter No. 586

CA A 1336 - Frazier (D)

Title: Prevailing Wages: Payroll Records

Summary: Relates to the deadline for filing a civil penalty assessment against a contractor or subcontractor for a violation under the public works provisions. Extends the deadline for filing an action regarding prevailing wages under a public works contract. Requires that any copy of a payroll record made available for inspection to be marked or obliterated only to prevent disclosure of an individual's social security number. Authorizes civil penalties only against the employer not paying the prevailing wage. 10/13/2013 Signed by Governor. Chaptered by Secretary of State. Chapter No. 792

CA S 377 - Lieu (D)

Title: Public Works: Project Determinations: Wage Assessments

Summary: Relates to the Director of Industrial Relations. Provides for public works project status determinations and appeals. Relates to the statute of limitations for commencing an action against an employer who fails to pay prevailing wages. 10/12/2013 Signed by Governor. Chaptered by Secretary of State. Chapter No. 780

CA S 54 - Hancock (D)

Title: Hazardous Materials: Skilled and Trained Workforce

Summary: Relates to stationary sources. Relates to a regulated substances accident risk. Includes petroleum. Requires that specified hazardous materials-related contractors, including journeypersons, be paid the applicable prevailing hourly wage rate. Requires the approval of a curriculum of in-person classroom and laboratory instruction for approved advanced safety training for workers at high hazard facilities. 10/13/2013 Signed by Governor. Chaptered by Secretary of State. Chapter No. 795

CA S 7 - Steinberg (D)

Title: Public Works: Charter Cities

Summary: Prohibits a charter city from receiving or using state funding or financial assistance for a construction project if the city has a charter provision or ordinance that authorizes a contractor to not comply with prevailing wage provisions on any public works contract. Prohibits state funding assistance for such projects for a specified period. Authorizes such assistance for a city with an ordinance requiring prevailing wages. Provides a minimum contract threshold for such requirement. 10/13/2013 Signed by Governor. Chaptered by Secretary of State. Chapter No. 794

## **Connecticut**

CT H 5088 - Davis C (R)

Title: Prevailing Wage Rate

Summary: Concerns the application of the prevailing wage rate to school and transportation projects; provides

property tax relief to towns; ensures that maximum funding is made available for local school and transportation projects. 03/19/2013 Failed Joint Favorable deadline.

CT H 5089 - Lavielle (R)

Title: State and Municipalities Financial Relief

Summary: Relates to financial relief to the state and municipalities and the prevailing wage threshold; provides financial relief to the state and municipalities by increasing the threshold amount for public works projects required to pay prevailing wages. 03/19/2013 Failed Joint Favorable deadline.

CT H 5091 - Davis C (R)

Title: Prevailing Wage Requirement

Summary: Exempts certain municipal projects from prevailing wage requirements; exempts from the prevailing wage requirements all municipal projects that do not receive state or federal funding. 03/19/2013 Failed Joint Favorable deadline.

CT H 5092 - Miller L (R)

Title: Prevailing Wage Thresholds

Summary: Concerns prevailing wage thresholds and their applicability to institutions of art and culture; provides financial relief to the state and municipalities by increasing the threshold amount for public works projects which require contractors to pay prevailing wages; encourages institutions of art and culture to undertake construction or renovation projects. 03/19/2013 Failed Joint Favorable deadline.

CT H 5094 - Miller L (R)

Title: Prevailing Wage Thresholds

Summary: Increases the prevailing wage thresholds for public works projects; provides financial relief to the state and municipalities by increasing the threshold amount for public works projects which require contractors to abide by prevailing wage Laws. 01/09/2013 To Joint Committee on Labor and Public Employees.

CT S 78 - Witkos (R)

Title: Prevailing Wage Threshold for Public Works Projects

Summary: Increases the prevailing wage threshold for public works projects; provides financial relief to the state and municipalities by increasing the threshold amount for public works projects required to pay prevailing wages and to ensure that future prevailing wage rates are indexed to the inflation rate. 03/19/2013 Failed Joint Favorable deadline.

CT S 99 - Witkos (R)

Title: STEAP and the Prevailing Wage Threshold

Summary: Concerns the Small Town Economic Assistance Program (STEAP) and the prevailing wage threshold; allows communities receiving STEAP grants to maximize the economic impact of these grants by removing any barriers that the prevailing wage laws may impose on public works projects. 03/19/2013 Failed Joint Favorable deadline.

CT S 125 - Markley (R)

Title: Elimination of the Prevailing Wage Standards

Summary: Concerns the elimination of the prevailing wage standards; provides local tax relief by eliminating all statutory mandates to abide by prevailing wage standards in the context of public works projects. 03/19/2013 Failed Joint Favorable deadline.

CT S 126 - Markley (R)

Title: Threshold Amount for Public Works Projects

Summary: Increases the threshold amount for public works projects subject to prevailing wage Laws; provides local tax relief by doubling the current threshold amounts that determine when public works projects must abide by prevailing wage Laws. 03/19/2013 Failed Joint Favorable deadline.

CT H 5365 - Piscopo (R)

Title: Prevailing Wage Changes

Summary: Concerns changes to the prevailing wage; increases the prevailing wage thresholds for municipal construction projects. 03/19/2013 Failed Joint Favorable deadline.

CT H 5366 - Piscopo (R)

Title: Prevailing Wage Threshold

Summary: Increases the prevailing wage threshold; provides financial relief to the state and municipalities by increasing the threshold at which public works projects will be subject to the prevailing wage laws. 03/19/2013 Failed Joint Favorable deadline.

CT H 5367 - Piscopo (R)

Title: Prevailing Wage Application

Summary: Concerns the application of the prevailing wage rate to school and transportation projects; provides property tax relief to towns and to ensure that maximum funding is made available for local school and transportation projects. 03/19/2013 Failed Joint Favorable deadline.

CT H 5368 - Piscopo (R)

Title: Prevailing Wage Laws

Summary: Concerns modernization of the prevailing wage laws; provides financial relief to the state and municipalities; increases immediately the threshold amount for public works projects required to pay prevailing wages; ensures that the threshold for prevailing wage laws keeps pace with inflation in the future. 03/19/2013 Failed Joint Favorable deadline.

CT H 5369 - Piscopo (R)

Title: Prevailing Wage Exemption

Summary: Concerns municipal projects and the prevailing wage; facilitates municipal public works projects by exempting certain projects from the prevailing wage requirements. 03/19/2013 Failed Joint Favorable deadline.

CT H 5370 - Piscopo (R)

Title: Prevailing Wage Exemption

Summary: Exempts certain municipal projects from prevailing wage rate requirements. 03/19/2013 Failed Joint Favorable deadline.

CT H 5371 - Rutigliano (R)

Title: Prevailing Wage Increase

Summary: Concerns the prevailing wage; increases the prevailing wage thresholds in order to encourage the state and municipalities to undertake public works projects. 03/19/2013 Failed Joint Favorable deadline.

CT H 5437 - Carter (R)

Title: Public Works Projects and Prevailing Wage Standard

Summary: Concerns private contributions to public works projects and the prevailing wage standard; ensures that the prevailing wage threshold does not include costs defrayed by funds by a private source. 03/19/2013 Failed Joint Favorable deadline.

CT H 5527 - Carpino (R)

Title: Inflation and the Prevailing Wage Threshold

Summary: Concerns inflation and the prevailing wage threshold; provides immediate financial relief to the state and municipalities by increasing the current prevailing wage threshold and to ensure that the prevailing wage threshold keeps pace with future inflation rates. 03/19/2013 Failed Joint Favorable deadline.

CT H 5688 - Williams S (R)

Title: Prevailing Wage Thresholds for Public Works Projects

Summary: Increases the prevailing wage thresholds for public works projects; increases the prevailing wage threshold for new construction and remodeling, refinishing, refurbishing, rehabilitation, alteration or repair of any public works project. 03/19/2013 Failed Joint Favorable deadline.

CT H 5693 - Sawyer (R)

Title: Private Contributions and the Prevailing Wage Threshold

Summary: Concerns private contributions and the prevailing wage thresholds; ensures that the prevailing wage threshold does not include costs defrayed by funds by a private source. 03/19/2013 Failed Joint Favorable deadline.

CT H 5694 - Sawyer (R)

Title: Small Town Economic Assistance Program

Summary: Concerns the Small Town Economic Assistance Program (STEAP) and increasing the prevailing wage threshold; reduces the economic burden on municipalities by providing that STEAP funded projects have a prevailing wage threshold of five hundred thousand dollars. 03/19/2013 Failed Joint Favorable deadline.

CT H 5695 - Willis (D)

Title: Prevailing Wage Threshold

Summary: Concerns financial relief to the state and municipalities and increasing the prevailing wage thresholds; betters undertake public works projects and to increase levels to be more in line with present costs. 03/19/2013 Failed Joint Favorable deadline.

CT H 5697 - Bolinsky (R)

Title: Contractors and Prevailing Wage Laws

Summary: Increases the current threshold amounts that require contractors to abide by prevailing wage laws; provides local tax relief by doubling the current threshold amounts that determine when public works projects must abide by prevailing wage Laws. 03/19/2013 Failed Joint Favorable deadline.

CT S 294 - Kane (R)

Title: Current Prevailing Wage Thresholds

Summary: Concerns the current prevailing wage thresholds; provides local tax relief and facilitates public works projects by doubling the current threshold amounts that determine when public works projects must abide by prevailing wage Laws. 03/19/2013 Failed Joint Favorable deadline.

CT H 5962 - Ackert (R)

Title: Contributions to Municipalities and the Prevailing Wage

Summary: Concerns state contributions to municipalities and the prevailing wage; exempts municipalities from the prevailing wage Laws unless the state contributes twenty-five per cent or more of the total cost of the municipal project. 03/19/2013 Failed Joint Favorable deadline.

CT H 5964 - Ackert (R)

Title: Prevailing Wage Threshold

Summary: Increases the prevailing wage threshold; amends the current prevailing wage thresholds. 03/19/2013 Failed Joint Favorable deadline.

CT H 6152 - O'Brien E (D)

Title: Prevailing Wage on Municipal Projects

Summary: Concerns the prevailing wage on municipal projects; allows municipalities to conduct construction and renovation projects at the lowest cost possible. 03/19/2013 Failed Joint Favorable deadline.

CT H 6230 - Urban (D)

Title: Prevailing Wage Thresholds and Inflation

Summary: Concerns prevailing wage thresholds and inflation; changes the prevailing wage thresholds to reflect cost changes experienced by municipalities undertaking public works projects. 03/19/2013 Failed Joint Favorable deadline.

## **Delaware**

DE H 6 - Briggs King (R)

Title: Prevailing Wage Requirements

Summary: Raises the dollar thresholds for public works projects subject to the prevailing wage requirement for new

construction and for alteration, repair, renovation, rehabilitation, demolition or reconstruction. Neither of these figures have been adjusted since 1994. 01/15/2013 To House Committee on House Administration.

DE H 7 - Briggs King (R)

Title: Prevailing Wage Requirements

Summary: Allows contracting agencies to opt out of the requirement that prevailing wages be paid to mechanics and laborers performing work on public works projects. 01/15/2013 To House Committee on House Administration.

## **Hawaii**

HI S 800 - Slom (R)

Title: Public Works Construction

Summary: Prohibits prevailing wage requirement for public works construction contracts or public work project contracts to be construed to require the retention of individuals, laborers, or mechanics who are represented by an exclusive representative of a collective bargaining unit. 03/07/2013 Failed First Crossover Deadline - First Year of Biennium.

## **Illinois**

IL H 2540 - Smiddy (D)

Title: Prevailing Wage Act

Summary: Amends the Prevailing Wage Act; deletes language requiring copies of determinations concerning the prevailing rate of wages to be filed with the Secretary of State. 08/05/2013 Signed by Governor. Public Act No. 173

IL S 1859 - Stadelman (D)

Title: Winnebago County Hotel Occupation Tax

Summary: Amends the Counties Code; authorizes Winnebago County by ordinance to impose, with municipal consent, a hotel operators' occupation tax at a percentage of gross rental receipts from renting, leasing or letting; creates a Tourism Facility Board; provides that project labor agreements for any sports, arts or entertainment facilities that receive revenue from such tax are public works within the Prevailing Wage Act; provides for labor agreements; provides for minority, female or disabled company commitments. 08/12/2013 Signed by Governor. Public Act No. 313

IL H 922 - Hurley (D)

Title: Prevailing Wage Act

Summary: Amends the Prevailing Wage Act; provides that contractors and subcontractors shall make and keep for a period of not less than a specified number of years from the date of the last payment on a contract or subcontract for public works, records of all workers employed on the project; provides that a public body must keep certain payroll records for such term; provides that actions for the failure to pay wages or compensation shall be brought within a certain number of years. 08/13/2013 Signed by Governor. Public Act No. 328

IL H 3223 - Beiser (D)

Title: Prevailing Wage Act

Summary: Amends the Prevailing Wage Act; requires contractors to include in record keeping the gross and net wage, hourly overtime rate, fringe benefit rates, and the sponsor and administrator of fringe benefit plans; provides for filing of the records with the Department of Labor; authorizes that Department to require electronic filing; requires that Department to create and provide a form for the filing of certified payrolls; defines terms. 08/16/2013 Signed by Governor. Public Act No. 482

IL H 1161 - Hoffman (D)

Title: Prevailing Wage Act

Summary: Amends the Prevailing Wage Act; makes a technical change in a Section concerning State policy. 03/22/2013 Rereferred to House Committee on Rules.

IL H 2888 - Sacia (R)

Title: Prevailing Wage Act

Summary: Amends the Prevailing Wage Act; provides that the Act does not apply to wages paid to all laborers, workers, and mechanics employed by or on behalf of a public body engaged in a public works project with a total cost of \$20,000 or less if the public body notifies the Department of Labor of each project for which the waiver is used within 60 days of commencing the project; provides that the Department shall make available a form with which public bodies may make this notification. 03/22/2013 Rereferred to House Committee on Rules.

IL H 924 - Hoffman (D)

Title: Prevailing Wage

Summary: Amends the Prevailing Wage Act; provides that a public body shall specify in the call for bids that each bidder be a responsible bidder; requires contractors and subcontractors to report the hours worked by minorities and females; requires the Department of Transportation, the Capital Development Board, and the State Toll Highway Authority report that information to the General Assembly. 11/06/2013 In Senate. Placed on Calendar Order Second Reading.

IL H 1795 - Sacia (R)

Title: Prevailing Wage Act

Summary: Amends the Prevailing Wage Act; makes a technical change in a Section concerning construction of the Act. 04/19/2013 Rereferred to House Committee on Rules.

IL H 987 - Reis (R)

Title: Prevailing Wage Act

Summary: Amends the Prevailing Wage Act; provides that the term public works does not include work done for a project used in production agriculture as defined in the Use Tax Act. 04/19/2013 Rereferred to House Committee on Rules.

IL S 1647 - Raoul (D)

Title: Design Build

Summary: Creates the Design-Build and Construction Manager/General Contractor Transportation Infrastructure Act; provides that the Department of Transportation is authorized to use the design-build project delivery method or the construction manager/general contractor delivery method for up to 5 transportation facilities for each delivery method; contains provisions concerning the procurement process and terms of the contract; provides that the Department of Transportation has eminent domain and quick take powers. 04/19/2013 Rereferred to Senate Committee on Assignments.

## **Iowa**

IA H 36 - Hunter (D)

Title: Hourly Wage

Summary: Requires a contractor to pay workers the same hourly wage plus fringe benefits for a public improvement costing more than \$25,000 as the contractor would pay workers for a private construction or improvement project; allows the per-hour wage rate to be based on what is normally paid in the area by contractors for similar projects, and to be adjusted on a yearly basis by the department of workforce development. 01/22/2013 In House Committee on Labor.

## **Kansas**

KS H 2320 - House Taxation Committee

Title: Public Charter School Act

Summary: Relates to creating the state public charter school act. Exempts charter schools from prevailing wage requirements.

KS S 196 - Senate Ways and Means Committee

Title: Public Charter School Act

Summary: Relates to creating the state public charter school act. Exempts charter schools from prevailing wage

requirements.

## **Kentucky**

KY S 105 - Westerfield (R)

Title: Wages and Hours

Summary: Relates to wages and hours; amends and repeals various sections of the Kentucky Revised Statutes to repeal the prevailing wage requirement, abolish the Prevailing Wage Review Board, and make conforming amendments. 02/11/2013 To Senate Committee on Economic Development, Tourism and Labor.

KY H 311 - DeCesare (R)

Title: Prevailing Wage in Education

Summary: Relates to prevailing wage in education; provides that the definition of public works shall not include all construction projects in elementary, secondary, and postsecondary buildings and facilities, and therefore, the prevailing wage requirements shall not apply to education building projects. 02/20/2013 Posted in committee. Posting waived.

KY H 312 - DeCesare (R)

Title: Prevailing Wage

Summary: Relates to prevailing wage; amends various KRS sections to comply with the repeal of the prevailing wage requirement. 02/20/2013 Posted in committee. Posting waived.

## **Maine**

ME H 762 - DeChant (D)

Title: State Prevailing Wage and Benefit Rates

Summary: Allows flexibility in the minimum hourly wage and benefit rates for workers employed in the construction of public works by the state or persons contracting with the state; allows any allocation between hourly wage and benefit rates, as long as the sum of the hourly wage and benefit rates equals the sum of the appropriate hourly wage and benefit rates determined by the Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Standards. 07/08/2013 Vetoed by Governor.

## **Maryland**

MD S 664 - Kittleman A (R)

Title: Wage Rate Law

Summary: Relates to procurement; relates to prevailing wage rate law; relates to repeal. 02/01/2013 To Senate Committee on Finance.

MD S 667 - Kittleman A (R)

Title: Wage School Construction

Summary: Relates to procurement; relates to prevailing wage; relates to school construction. 02/01/2013 To Senate Committee on Finance.

MD S 833 - Brinkley (R)

Title: Frederick County

Summary: Exempts Frederick County, as to a specified contract, from the provisions of the State procurement law concerning minority business enterprises; exempts Frederick County, under specified circumstances, from the provisions of the State procurement law concerning prevailing wage rates. 03/15/2013 From Senate Committee on Education, Health and Environmental Affairs: Reported unfavorably.

MD S 878 - Manno (D)

Title: Wage Rates for School Construction

Summary: Repeals the limitation on the applicability of the prevailing wage rate law to the construction of an
