AZ	H 2177	Primary Election Candidates	04/18/2011 - Vetoed	This bill would have required that a presidential candidate must provide a long form birth certificate and proof of natural born citizenship.	Miscellaneous
CA	A 142	Criminal Procedure: Pleas	09/06/2011 - Vetoed	This bill sought to require the court, after January 1, 2012, to inform defendants that they may be charged with a separate federal offense if they are deported and return illegally to the United States.	Law_Enforcement
CA	A 532	Pupil Assessments	10/08/2011 - Vetoed	This bill would have required state school assessments to be "valid, reliable, and comparable" when assessing students who are limited English proficient and/or have developmental disabilities.	Education
CA	S 69	Budget Act of 2011	06/16/2011 - Vetoed	This budget bill would have stipulated that providers of immigrant services such as ESL, citizenship classes, and adult education receiving certain funding must prioritize services to immigrants facing the loss of public benefits. The bill provided funding for migrant child care and lists mandatory services that citizenship and naturalization preparation services must offer.	Budgets
CA	S 111	Civil Rights: Language Restrictions	09/06/2011 - Vetoed	This bill would have made it a violation for a business to have a policy that requires, limits, or prohibits the use of any language, unless the policy is justified by a business necessity.	Employment
ME	S 102	Timber Harvesting	06/09/2011 - Vetoed	This bill would have prohibited the Department of Conservation, Bureau of Parks and Lands from permitting timber on land under its jurisdiction to be harvested using persons employed under the federal H2 bonded labor program.	Employment

MN	S	760	Human Services	05/24/2011 - Vetoed	This bill would have mandated payments to be made for emergency medical care and services that are provided to noncitizens, regardless of immigration status.	Health
MN	S	887	Jobs, Economic Development, and Housing	05/24/2011 - Vetoed	This bill sought to authorize a one-time appropriation of \$80,000 to Lifetrack Resources for its immigrant and refugee collaborative program, including those related to job-seeking skills and workplace orientation, intensive job development, functional work English, and on-site job coaching.	Budgets
MN	S	958	Public Safety	05/24/2011 - Vetoed	This bill sought to authorize appropriations to the federal immigration and customs enforcement rapid REPAT program. It also would have given states the opportunity to participate in the program.	Law_Enforcement
MT	H	492	Immigration Sanctuary Policies	05/12/2011 - Vetoed	This bill would have prohibited immigration sanctuary policies and mad them punishable by withholding of funds.	Law_Enforcement
MT	S	366	Welfare Laws	05/12/2011 - Vetoed	This bill would have provided the terms of ineligibility or sanctions against a relative or other family member who fails to comply with a family investment agreement. It stated that aliens would not receive assistance for this issue.	Public_Benefits
NJ	A	3584	Work Now New Jersey Program	02/18/2011 - Vetoed	This bill would have specified that unemployment benefits would not be paid to an individual who was not lawfully present for the purpose of performing the services.	Employment
NM	H	298	Sex Offender Registration	04/07/2011 - Vetoed	This bill would have required sex offenders to submit copies of their passports and immigration documents to the state.	Law_Enforcement

NM	S	38	Health Insurance Exchange	04/08/2011 - Vetoed	This bill would have enacted the New Mexico Health Insurance Exchange Act. It specified that a "qualified individual" for insurance would be a person who is, or is expected to be during the time of enrollment, a citizen or national of the United States or an alien who is lawfully present.	Health
NV	A	550	State Ports of Entry	06/17/2011 - Vetoed	This bill would have required that vehicles are subjected to inspection by peace officers and other inspectors for issues such as safety, equipment, weight, load and emissions.	Law_Enforcement
