CA	A 2676	Agricultural Employee Safety	This legislation requires employers to provide agriculture workers performing outdoor work with shade and potable water. Failure to comply would result in imprisonment for up to six months, a \$10,000 fine, or a combination of the two, however, if injury were to occur, it could be upwards of one year imprisonment, a \$25,000 fine, or a combination of the two.	09/30/2012 - Vetoed		Employment
CA	A 889	Domestic Work Employees	The legislation states that the majority of domestic workers are women of color and immigrants who are subject to mistreatment, harsh conditions, abuse and exploitation. The legislation advocates for industry-specific protections and labor standards for domestic workers that provide them with equality, respect and dignity in the workplace.	09/30/2012 - Vetoed		Employment
CA	A 1081	Federal Immigration Policy Enforcement	This legislation seeks to change implementation of the Secure Communities program by adding: protections for non-criminal individuals, limitations on which individuals' information are shared with ICE and additional public information requirements.	09/30/2012 - Vetoed		Law_Enforcement

NJ	A 718	Public School District Letter	The Department of Education shall biannually distribute a letter to each school district reminding the district of the obligation to enroll resident students regardless of immigration status and in accordance with the rules and regulations of the State Board of Education. NJ	A 3201	Gross Income Tax Rate on Income Exceeding \$1 Million	This tax legislation increases the gross income tax rate on taxable income exceeding \$1 million.
