

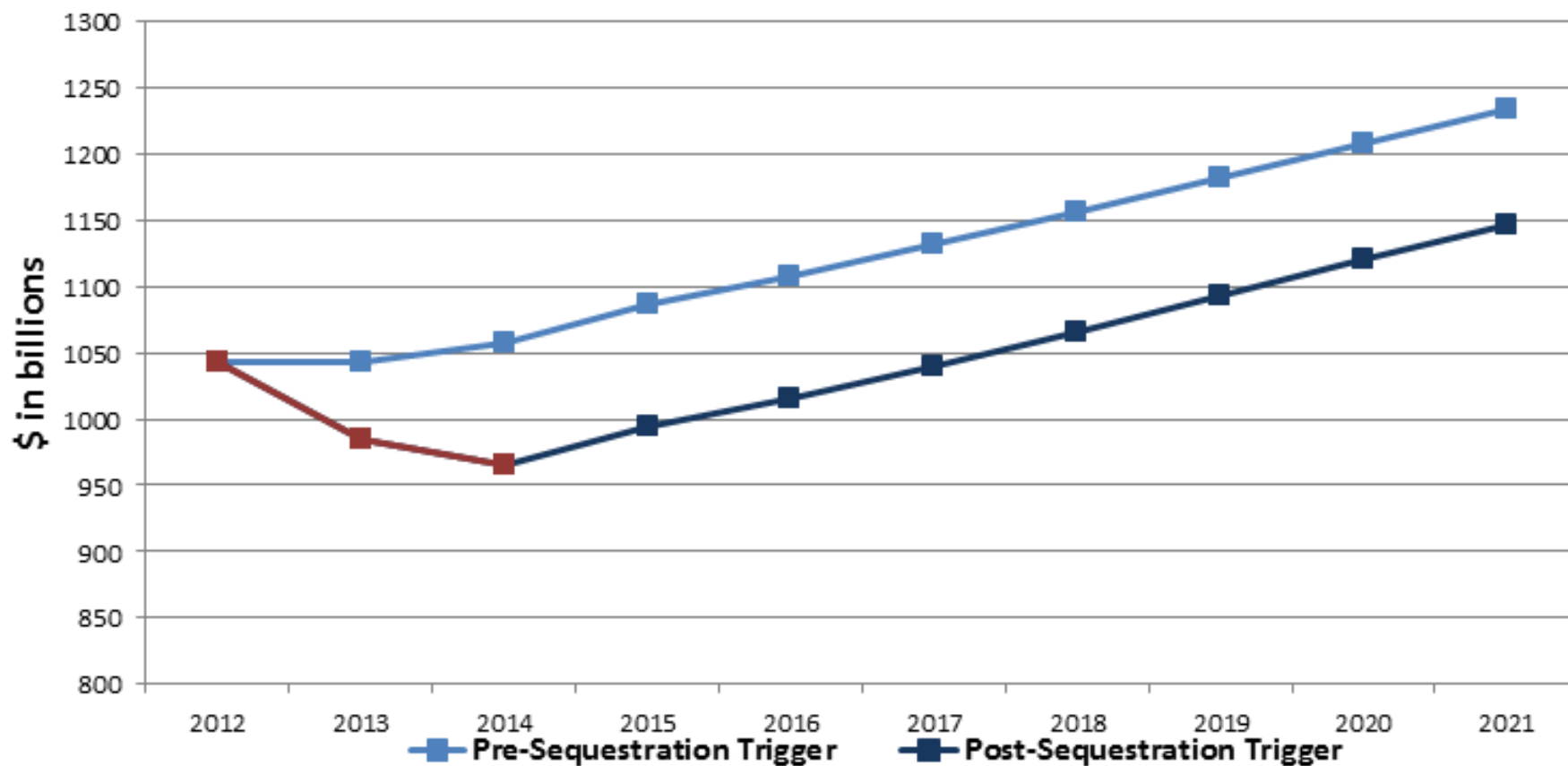

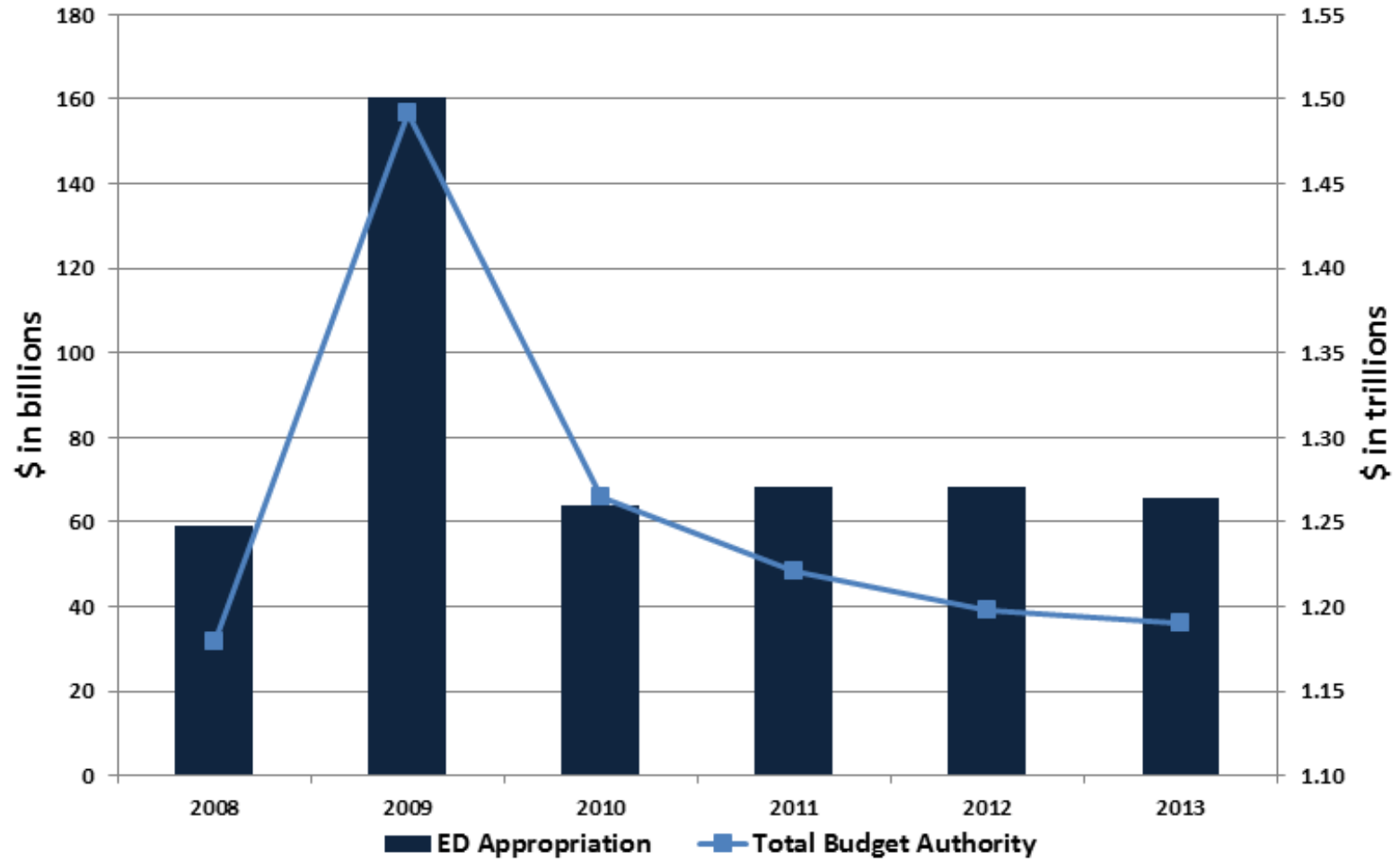

## Discretionary Spending Limits Pre- and Post-Sequestration Trigger



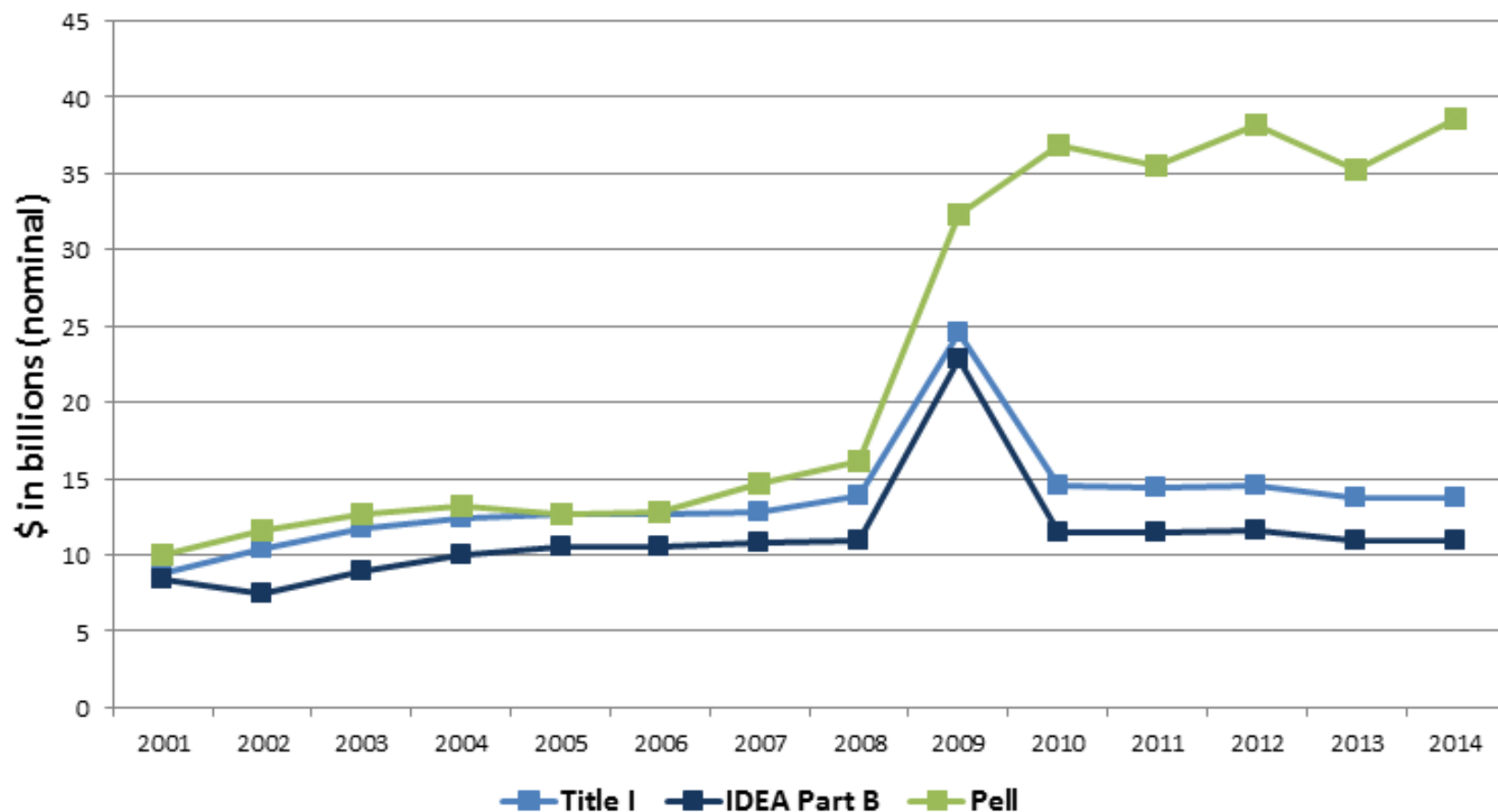

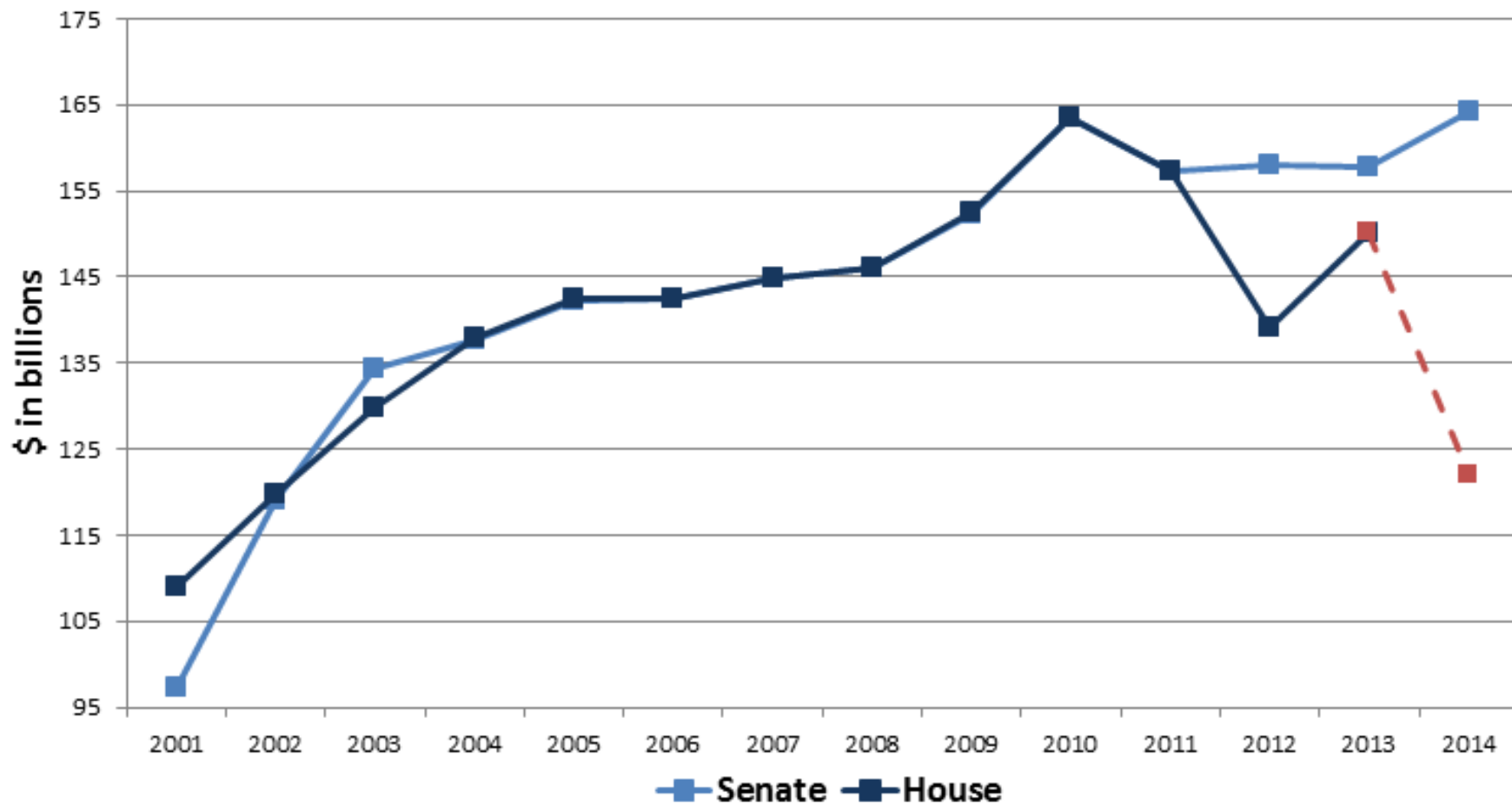
## Federal Education Spending on Pell Grants, Title I Grants, IDEA Grants, FY 2001 -- FY 2014



*NOTE: Pell Grant funding includes mandatory and discretionary spending.*

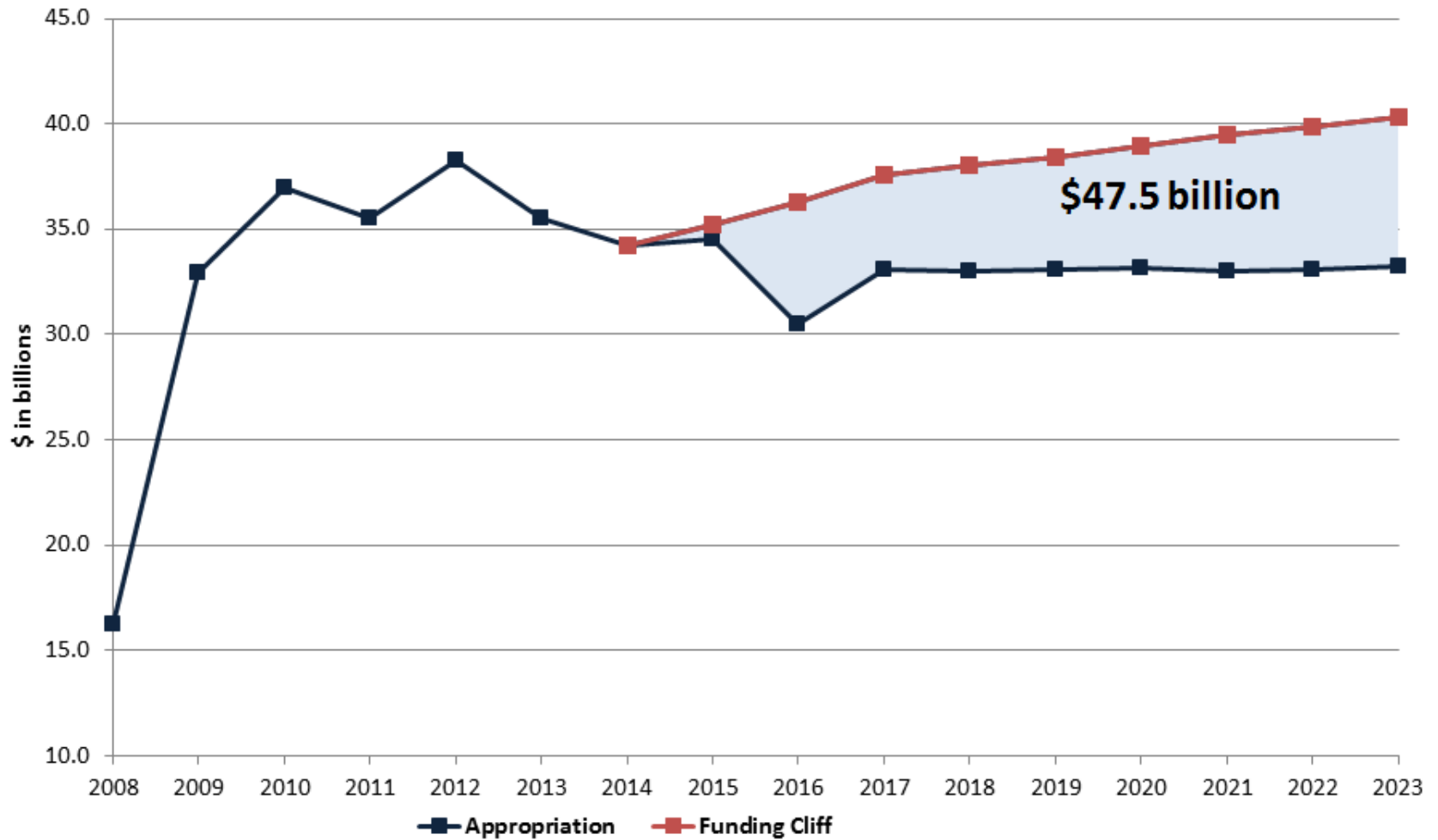
