Hunger in America

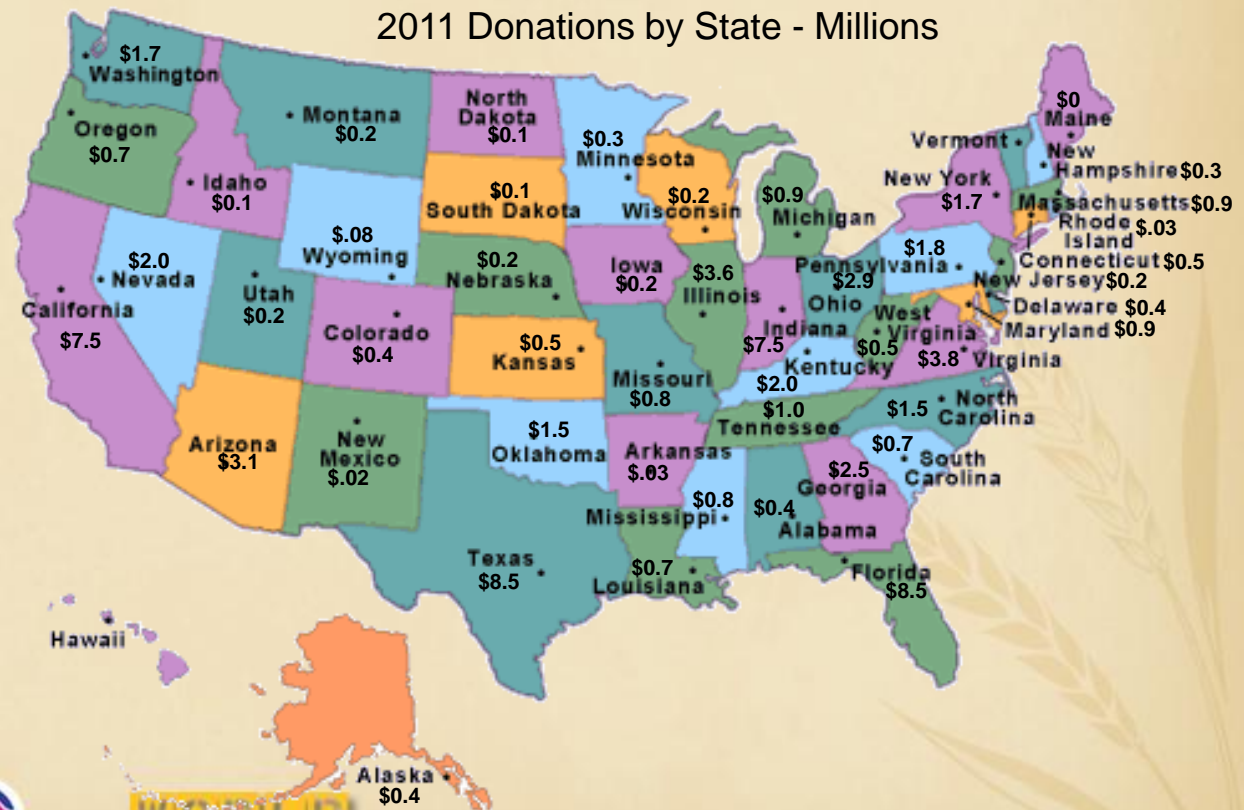
- 48.8 million Americans lack the means to get enough nutritious food on a regular basis
- One in six people in the United States do not get enough food to be healthy and lead an active life
- More than 16 million children (nearly one in five children in America) struggle with hunger
- 10.5 million kids eligible for free or reduced-price school breakfast do not get it due (parents unaware that program exist)
- Six out of 7 eligible kids do not get free summer meals



Harvest

Founded in 1992, Harvest is an extension of our global World Hunger Relief Campaign:

- Largest prepared food donation program
- Donating over 11 million pounds of our product each year
- Averaging \$60 million in fair market value in donations each year



How It Works

Participating Restaurant

1. Once product reaches hold time/incorrect order made, product placed in food & freezer safe pans provided by FDC
2. Associate places product in freezer
3. Associate logs donation amount into E-Log system
4. Non-Profit partner picks product up 2 to 3 times a week
5. Product re-heated/repurposed and served to those in need

Food Donation Connection

1. Identifies local relief agency
2. Provides program materials to restaurant including food safe pans and training materials
3. Assists restaurants via harvest support center
4. Tracks and monitors participation and donations by restaurant
5. Provides yearly record of donations for Tax Reporting



Celebrating 20 Years

Yum! Harvest is making a difference in the fight against hunger. During the past 20 years our restaurants have:

- Donated over 125 million pounds of product with a fair market value of \$600 million.
- Supported over 3,000 hunger relief agencies in the United States and counting.
- Offset over 150,000 tons of methane from landfill



Harvest restaurants donate on average over 5,000 lbs. of product each year to their local hunger relief agency
