Estimate of reduction of Police officers, and EMT'S, teachers, firefighters. • Impact of sequestration on infrastructure, families, border security, government personnel etc. 	No later than 60 days after date of enactment
	Secretary of Defense	<u>Report should include:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Impact on National Defense accounts using enacted levels of appropriations. • Impact on ongoing operations, and the safety of United States Military personnel; impact of the readiness of armed forces. • Estimates in the reduction in force of civilian personnel, and timing of reduction 	No later than August 15 2012

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	The president	<u>Report should include:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Discretionary appropriations- amounts necessary to achieve required reduction. • Reductions required for each non exempt and exempt direct spending account at the program, project, and activity level • For the defense and non defense functions amounts necessary to achieve required reduction • Using FY2013 enacted appropriations Bill or Continuing resolution 	No later than 30 days after date of enactment
S. 3254 FY2013 Defense Authorization	Secretary of Defense	<u>Report should include:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The impact on defense of sequestration of funds authorized and appropriated for FY2013. • List of the program, project, and activities across the department of defense, and military that would be reduced or terminated as a result of sequestration. • Estimate of the number value of contracts that will be terminated or altered as a result of sequestration 	No later than August 15 2012
H.R. 5872 – S. 3228 Sequestration Transparency Act	The president	<u>Report should include:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • An identification of each account to be sequestered and estimates of the level of sequesterable budgetary resources, and resulting outlay reductions at the program, project, and activity level based upon enacted levels of appropriations. (FY 2013 appropriated levels or continuing resolution) • For direct spending- estimate reductions for the defense and non defense functions based on current law of the sequestration. • Percentages and amounts necessary to achieve required reduction levels 	No later than 30 days after the date of enactment
