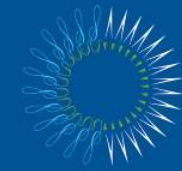

Upgrading Voter Registration

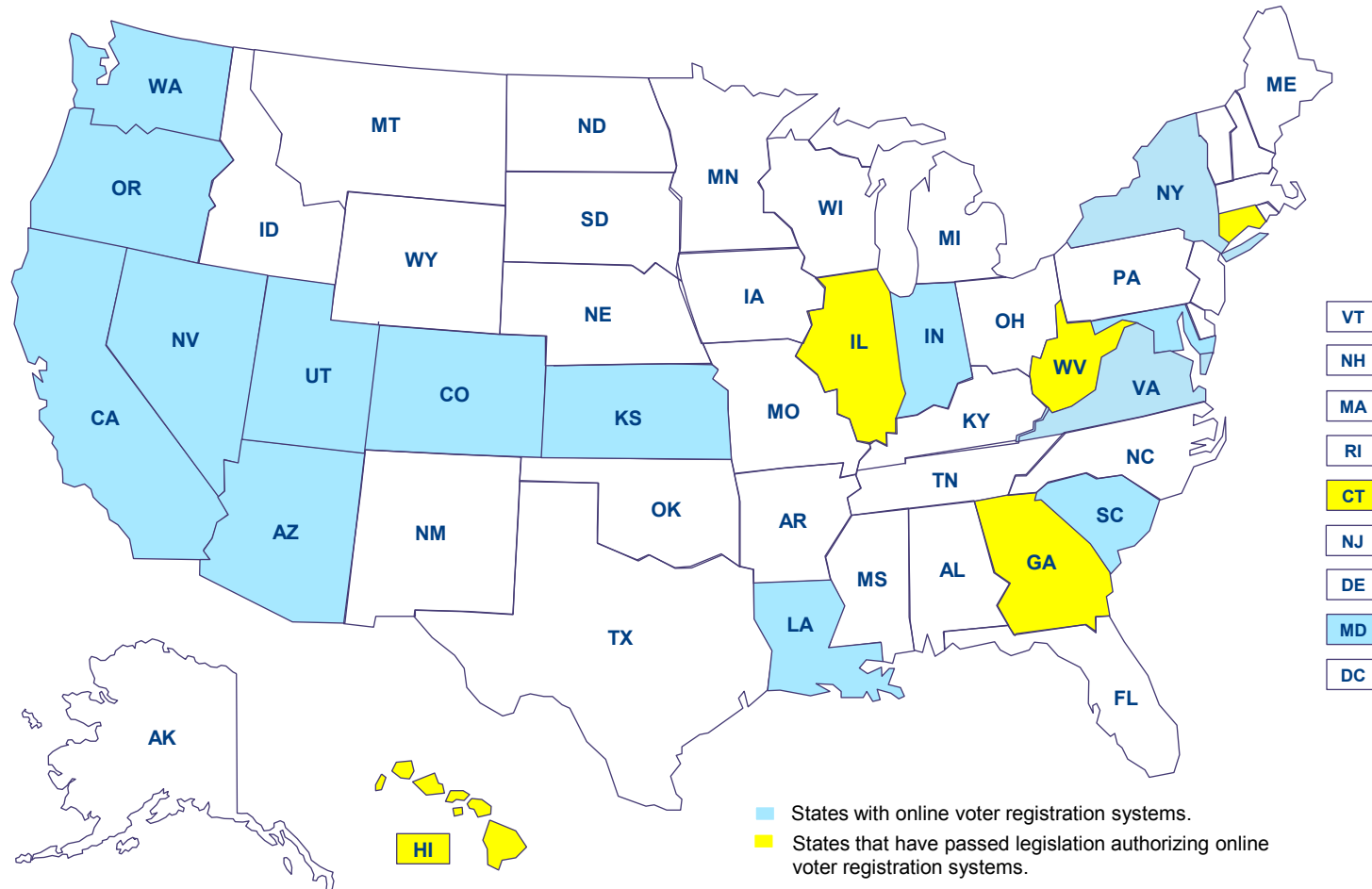


- **Better data into the system**
 - Online registration
 - Automated systems at motor vehicles agencies
- **Better use of data**
 - Electronic Registration Information Center (ERIC)

- Little research on how states have implemented OVR
 - NCSL survey
 - Brennan Center
- Provide states an idea of how others have rolled out their systems
- Asked 50 detailed questions of the 13 states with OVR in place by June of this year
- Responses from **ALL states**

How it all began

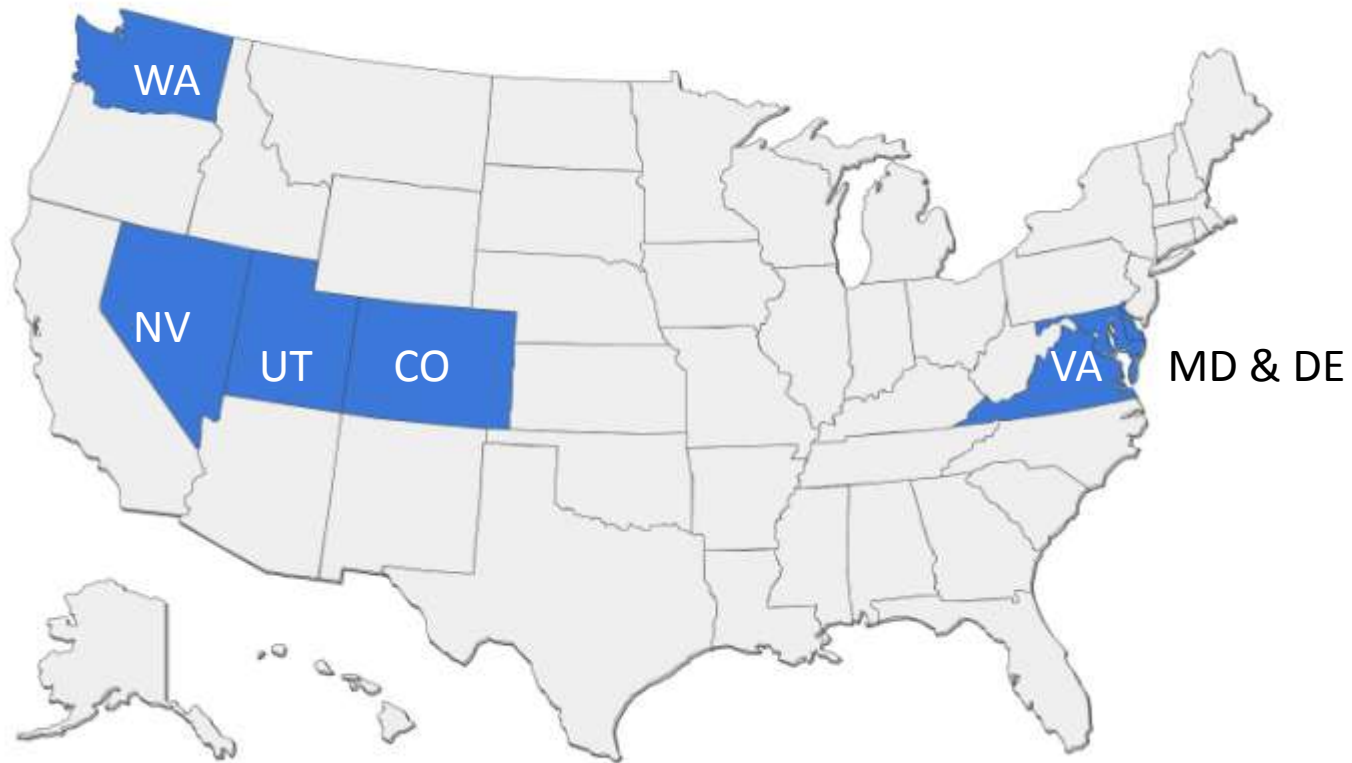
- Arizona was the first to rollout OVR in 2002.
 - More than **4 million** online voter registration transactions from 2002-2012
- **10 of the 13 states** used legislation to enact OVR.
- **7 states** built their systems in house, **3** used an outside vendor, and **3** used both internal staff and outside vendors
- Average Cost = **\$240,000**

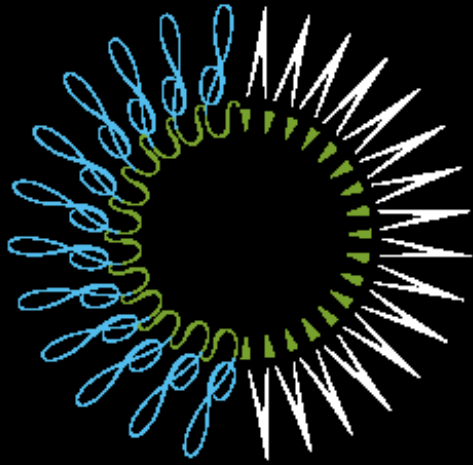
