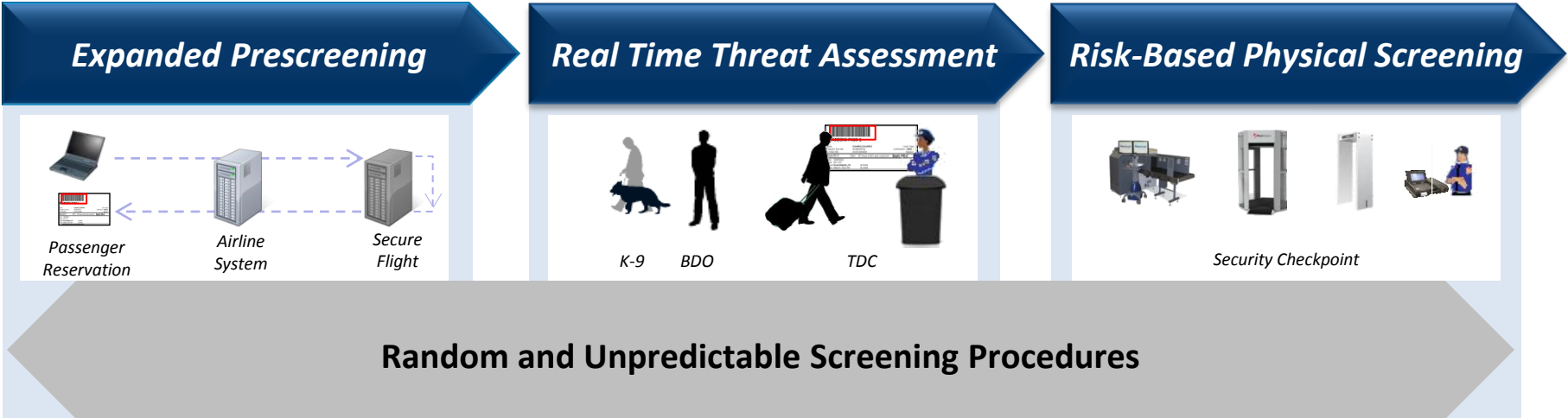

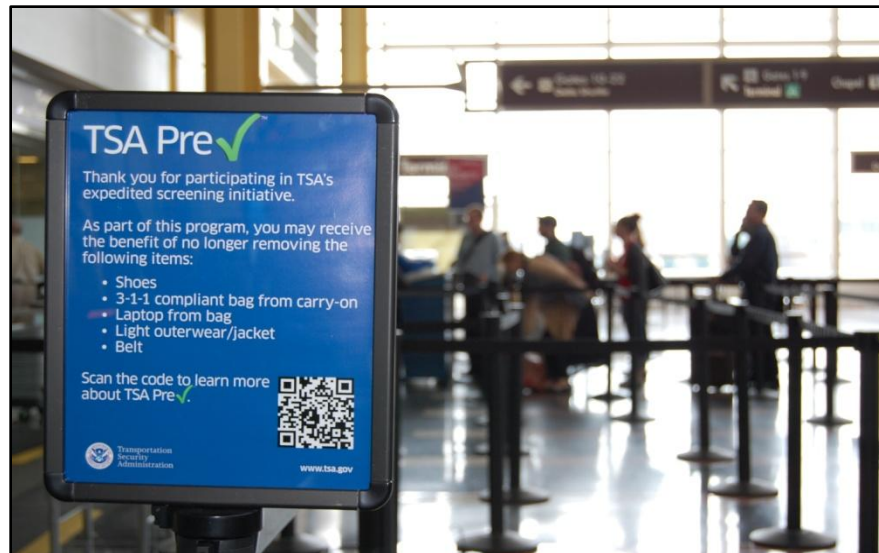
# Selected Elements of TSA's Risk-Based Security

- Honor Flights: Nationwide implementation complete
- Passengers 12 and Younger: Nationwide implementation complete
- Passengers 75 and Older: Nationwide implementation complete
- Known Crew Member: Expansion to nation's busiest airports underway
- TSA Pre✓™: Expansion to nation's busiest airports underway
- Active Duty Military: Testing at two airports; additional to follow



# TSA Pre<sup>™</sup> Expedited Passenger Screening

- Can Include No Longer Removing:
  - Shoes
  - 3-1-1 compliant bag from carry-on
  - Laptop from bag
  - Light outerwear/jacket
  - Belt
- Random and Unpredictable Measures
- No Passenger Guaranteed Expedited Screening



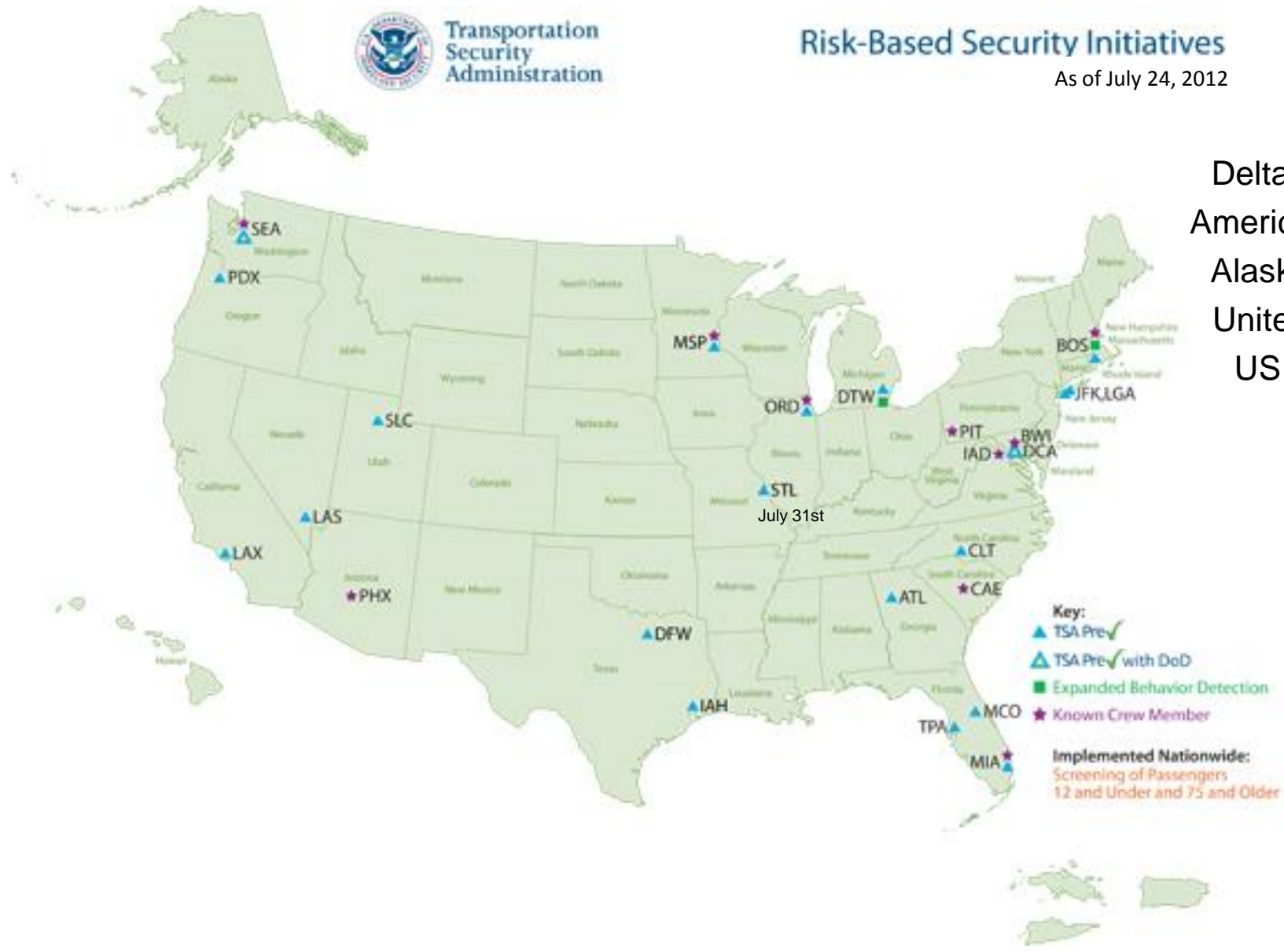
# TSA Pre™ as of Late July: 19 Airports, 5 Participating Airlines

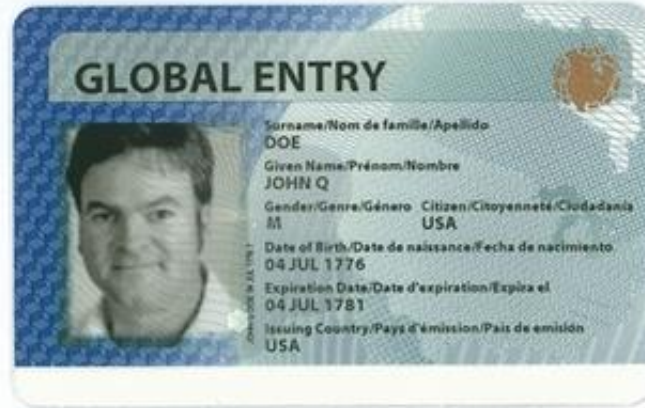
